- Sewer Interconnect Project is set for May 27th, 2022. Funding applications for the Madison Village Wetlands Trail and for the ADA improvements to the playground at Dana's Park have been submitted to the State Senate and State House of Representatives. CT is also working on the CDBG Funding applications for those same projects. Sheetz has begun their site work for installing all of their utilities and that will remain on-going. Also, for the Great Lakes Way dedication to take place the items that still remain to be completed include sanitary pump station, the roadway lighting, and the grass restoration. Ms. Drown inquired if the contaminated soil that was encountered at the Sheetz site was addressed. Mr. Bailey answered that the contaminated soil was cleaned up and removed from the site.
- Fiscal Officer's report No report. Ms. Crockett is out recovering from surgery.
- ➤ Police Chief's report No report. Chief McIntosh is out of town for a work conference.
- Administrator's report Mr. Bailey announced the Concerts in the Park schedule is completed and has been published. Also, the design work for the I90 Signalization Project has been completed and signed off by ODOT. We will bill those charges to Love's and Sheetz, and the next step to that project will be directed by ODOT.
