Mayor Britton invited all in attendance to join in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Mayor Britton requested that everyone observe a moment of silence. Council Members Mr. Adams, Mr. Donaldson, Ms. Drown, Mr. Lee and Mr. Vest were in attendance. Also in attendance were Administrator Mr. Bailey, Law Director Mr. Szeman and Village Assistant Engineer Andy Lubonovic. Fiscal Officer Kristie Crockett & Police Chief Troy McIntosh were not in attendance.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT:

➤ **Engineer's report –**

Mr. Lubonovic reported in Mr. Haibach's absence. He reported that in regards to the Sanitary Sewer Interconnect Project, so far Chivers Construction has removed 1,700 linear feet of pipe and four manholes. They have installed eight manholes and have installed 2,417 linear feet of 30" pipe. They currently have two crews working. The first crew has installed the second bore casing on Hubbard Road. They will be installing 30' pipe for the bore casing. The second crew is continuing work on Middle Ridge Road.

A brief discussion took place regarding the placement on the damming system.

➤ **Fiscal Officer's report –**

Administrator Bailey reported that Mrs. Crockett was supposed to be in Columbus for training, however; due to illness she was unable to make the trip.

➤ **Police Chief's report –**

Administrator Bailey reported that Chief McIntosh is out ill as well.

➤ **Administrator's report –**

Administrator Bailey reported that work is still continuing for the Concerts in the Park and the Outdoor Market.

He stated that in regards to the insurance review, he and Fiscal Officer Crockett went through the contact. He does not see a down side in making the switch.

In regards to the street lights on Dayton Road, he reported that he has submitted a request however; First Energy has not gotten back to him yet.

COMMISSION AND COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Councilman Vest reported that the Planning & Zoning Committee is working on a proposal that will come before Council for an Airbnb. The Airbnb's would be on State Routes within the Village and would be a Conditional Use. The Airbnb's would have to be registered and would be subject to lodging taxes.

FINAL HEARING OF PERSONS BEFORE COUNCIL:

Ken Takacs (164 Huntington Woods Drive) – Mr. Takacs was in attendance to announce that a pact has been put together at the Board of Elections called Citizens for Madison Village Police. He stated that a bank account has been opened in this name to have a depository for funds. Mr. Takacs stated that there is a lot to be done before the primary election. He would like to have a

pancake breakfast so the residents can meet the Police Officers and let the Officers explain to them the need for a levy.

Mr. Takacs stated that he has seen over the years that Police Departments are not hiring candidates newly out of the Academy. They want a Veteran Officer, so they “steal” them from other cities. Small Communities like Madison Village cannot compete with that. He stated that going to Full Time Officers is more expensive, and then loose them to a higher paying organization, the Village is constantly training new Officers, so we have to be competitive.

He asked Council for their support, talk to friends and neighbors. Anyone who is willing to support and provide donations would be great.

He is also asking for the Police Department to recognize their responsibilities for this goal as they will be the direct recipients of the levy money.

He stated that he doesn't think that we need a door-to-door campaign. He feels that the signage campaign and the poster campaign will work. He stated that these need to get up into key areas and ask some of the businesses if they can be placed there.

Mayor Britton explained that when he met with the Department, they were instructed not to promote the levy while on duty. Mr. Takacs stated that they have a duty, when they aren't working, to help get the levy off the ground.

Mr. Takacs stated he is looking forward to hearing from Chief McIntosh and the Officers from the Department in order to get this campaign moving.

A brief discussion took place regarding inside millage.

NEW BUSINESS

Mayor's Report: -

Mayor Britton stated that he is getting complaints regarding “jake brakes”. Discussion took place regarding signage. Mayor Britton stated that if the Village does not have signs in place for this, we will get them.

In closing, Councilman Lee asked if, at the next meeting, Council could enter into executive session to discuss security at Village Hall and Council Meetings.

ORDINANCE NO. 17 - 2023

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF EMPLOYEE DISHONESTY AND FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE INSURANCE COVERAGE IN LIEU OF INDIVIDUAL SURETY BONDS FOR VILLAGE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village is a member of the Public Entities Pool of Ohio ("PEP"), an inter-governmental self-insurance pool established pursuant to § 2744.081 of the Ohio Revised Code, which provides for the pooling of financial and administrative resources for Ohio political subdivisions to afford self-insurance protection; and

WHEREAS, Art. XIX, § 19.5 of the Charter provides that the Council is vested with the power "to establish such bonds of employees whether elected or appointed as in the opinion of the Council are necessary for the faithful discharge of their duties;" and

WHEREAS, House Bill 291 was signed into law on December 20, 2018 and became effective March 20, 2019; authorizes the use of an "employee dishonesty and faithful performance of duty policy," instead of individual surety bonds, for employees and appointees who are otherwise required by law to acquire a bond before entering upon the discharge of duties; and

WHEREAS, the Village has available through PEP employee dishonesty and faithful performance coverage; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Village to exercise its Charter and applicable statutory powers to purchase officer and employee dishonesty and faithful performance policy coverage through PEP for all officers and employees required to be bonded pursuant to law in the coverage amount of \$250,000.00, per employee / officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF MADISON VILLAGE, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and approval herein given to purchase through PEP officer and employee dishonesty and faithful performance of duty policy coverage which coverage is and shall be in lieu individual surety bonds for the officers and employees who are otherwise required by law to acquire a surety bond before entering upon the discharge of duties.

SECTION 2. It is Council's express purpose and intent that this dishonesty and faithful performance of duty policy coverage through PEP is and shall be in furtherance of and compliant with R.C. § 3.061 to the full extent that Ohio statutory law may, independently of the Charter, require surety bonding and such that the policy shall apply as follows:

- 1) An officer, employee, or appointee shall be considered qualified to hold the office or employment, without acquiring a bond, on the date the oath of office is taken, certified, and filed as required by law.

- 2) An officer, employee, or appointee shall have the employee dishonesty and faithful performance of duty policy in effect before the individual's term of office or employment and the officer, employee or appointee shall not commence the discharge of duties until coverage is documented.
- 3) All officers, employees, or appointees who would otherwise be required to file a bond before commencing the discharge of duties shall be covered by and are subject to the employee dishonesty and faithful performance of duty policy instead of a surety bond requirement.
- 4) The coverage amount for an officer, employee, or appointee under an employee dishonesty and faithful performance of duty policy shall be equal to or greater than the maximum amount of the bond otherwise required by law.
- 5) Elected officials, prior to taking the oath of office and holding office, shall obtain approval of the intent to use the PEP coverage agreement and affirm that the public entities coverage complies with R.C. § 3.061.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including § 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety of the inhabitants of this Village, and for the further reason that faithful performance coverage must be entered into forthwith so as to provide continuous protection against losses; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and immediately upon its passage.
