MIDWAY 2020-2021 PARENT INVOLVEMENT POLICY

The Every Student Succeeds Act requires Midway to have a parent involvement policy for the purpose of informing and providing opportunities for parents/guardians to be involved in the educational process of their children. Midway will provide the following in order to build a positive partnership between the school and parents/guardians:

- Midway will host an annual Back to School night when parents/guardians can meet their student's teachers. Parents will receive information regarding rights and responsibilities to be involved in their student's education. Midway will also inform parents of the school's responsibilities that are required under Title I legislation.
- Midway will offer opportunities throughout the school year to help parents gain an understanding of federal and state academic standards, including testing and test results. Midway teachers and parents will be given opportunities to work together to monitor each student's academic achievement.
- Parent conferences for all grades will be held in October and March. During the conferences, teachers will present current information to parents/guardians concerning their student's academic progress.
- Midway teachers will have ongoing and continuous contact with parents/guardians concerning the academic progress of their student. Parents/guardians will be available to discuss student academic achievement with teachers at school by appointment. Parents may also choose to communicate with teachers via email or phone conference.
- Midway will participate in a school-parent compact designed by parents/guardians and school staff that effectively outlines how parents/guardians, school staff and students share the responsibility for academic achievement.
- Midway will provide opportunities for parents/guardians to volunteer and participate in and observe classroom activities to improve academic achievement.
- Midway will provide educational resources and materials for parents/guardians to use that will assist children at home. Midway will also host activities such as Literacy Night to improve academic achievement.
- Midway will ask for parent/guardian input on policies and procedures through surveys, informal discussions, and from parents serving on committees to ensure continued parent/guardian views and ideas are included.
- Midway teachers and administrators will meet with parents/guardians to provide information concerning the Every Student Succeeds Act, as well as other accountability issues.
- Midway will ensure all information related to school and parent/guardian programs, meetings and activities will be in an understandable format. Midway will make every effort to have interpreters, when needed, for communication between school and home.
