CLUBHOUSE TO REOPEN

New and updated documentation was issued by the Government on 30th June which gives a little more clarity to how and when to open the club. We are in a strong position because we are (apart from the Parish Council), the sole users of our premises

The Committee have agreed that the clubhouse can re-open on Monday 13 July 2020, provided that strict guidelines are followed.

I am sending out a set of instructions which are being sent to EVERY member for you all to read, digest and comply.

The main guidelines are on numbers in the premises, cleaning and recording attendance as well as signing that cleaning has been completed. These are all based on our best calculation of the lockdown rules in force from this weekend.

We could delay until the end of the month when we will have all the PPE in place. By opening on the 13th we may not get all the face screens in place but should have them by the end of the month. Everything else will be present to allow us to open.

Based on the Government stipulations and the limits of our building, the committee have agreed a general maximum for each POD of FOUR regular attendees, with the ability for a 5th member to be added by phoning to book a slot. For ease we are calling these groups "PODS".

If we need additional times to meet demand, these can be arranged as we have full access any day of the week, morning, afternoon or evening.

The committee have agreed to forming a series of PODS. Each POD will meet on a different day (MONDAY MORNING,

TUESDAY MORNING or THURSDAY MORNING, plus WEDNESDAY EVENING. There is provision to add a fifth member to any POD but this will have to be booked and confirmed prior to attendance by ringing me on 01225 774440.

Each POD will be shown through the process of opening/closing and cleaning as well as registering attendance..

YOU all need to be thinking when you would prefer to come in (I have several tentative suggestions at the moment, but will need answers from <u>everyone</u> in the next few days.

We must all remember that the majority of our members are classed as being at a vulnerable age and several of us have family that are at even greater risk, so we must all follow the guidelines.

There have already been approaches for the N group to meet on Monday, for part of the 00 group to meet on Tuesday and another part on Thursday. Wednesday will become a planning/discussion day rather than a working day and is open for any member to book any of the FIVE places.

Please let me know your wishes as soon as possible. If additional days are required this can be arranged! If you don't let me know, you will not be allocated a space at this stage.
