To provide a premier arts and humanities center which will host and showcase our local and regional artisans and performers.

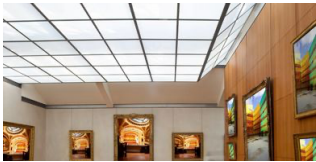
Planned Services

Our Mission

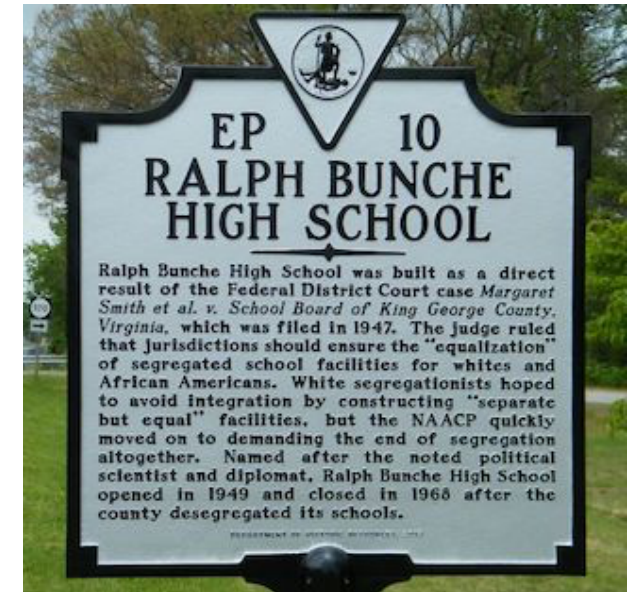
Foster community growth and development through the modes of philosophy, literature, art, music, theater, and history with an appreciation of African-American Heritage.

The Ralph Bunche High School building was constructed in 1949 to provide “separate but equal” educational opportunities to African American students in King George County schools and remained in service until King George integrated its schools in 1968. The building is on the Virginia National Register of Historic Places.
