CHECKLIST FOR THE SPRING PERFORMANCE:

- ✓ Please be sure that you are up to date on tuition and costumes. Costume balances are due by May 15th. If you need to make special arrangements, please contact the studio at contact@ozarkdance.com or 417-581-7101.
- ✓ Please check the costume book on the table to correct any spelling errors on your child's name. (Be sure that you are listed with each dance that you are in!) We use that information for the program, and we want to be accurate. You will also find information on personal accessories, tights, shoes, hair, and make-up in the costume book.

COSTUME RULES:

- 1. Please DO NOT wear costumes Except for Picture Day, Dress Rehearsal and Recital.
- 2. Mark costumes, accessories, shoes, hangers, everything with initials or name. Items left at the theater will be taken to the studio.
- 3. DO NOT wear costumes in the car.
- 4. Do not eat or drink anything in costume.
- 5. Wear a robe, smock, or big shirt that fastens in front (nothing that pulls over the head) so hair and makeup are not messed up when removed.

Costumes cannot be replaced and are fragile and difficult to clean. After the performance they are yours forever, so please be patient.

Recital Pictures: ODA's very own Laura Nowakowski will be taking our recital pictures this year. They will be May 10th at St. Joseph the Worker. Please refer to the last page of this newsletter for your child's picture time. Cash, Check or Venmo for photography purchase only. It will be digital, and will include a group photograph and an individual portrait. An email will be sent, and an announcement will be made on Facebook when they are available to be picked up in the studio.

Recital Flowers:

ODA mom Denise Jameson is organizing our recital flowers. Flowers may be pre-ordered and picked up in the lobby of the Theater the evening of the performance. Pre Order forms will be available at Pictures. There will be limited quantities of Flowers available for purchase at the performance but it is suggested you preorder to ensure you have a bouquet waiting for your dancer. Order form is also available on BAND.

Classes and Rehearsals:

We ask that students follow our Dress Code, listed in the Student Handbook. Summer and warm weather do not affect the discipline of our training. **Tights or leggings are required.** Hair is to be pulled back away from the face for all classes and secure against the head for ballet.

Please make attending your classes a priority. It is so important to have all the dancers present. There will not be time to teach choreography for dances during these rehearsals. The schedule for May 27th - May 31st is attached. As we get closer to the performance, it is important to be in class and at rehearsal. EACH of you are a vital part of a much bigger picture. A stage performance is truly a group project, and when even a small part is missing, everyone is affected.

Miscellaneous Information::

2025 Ozark Dance Academy Recital t-shirts are on order for each student. Additional shirts will be ordered as needed.

We will review the Theater Rules during classes. A copy is attached and will be posted. Please review them with your dancer and know them for yourself.

We do not have reserved or saved seating. If there is someone in your party that has special needs, please let us know so we can arrange seating accommodations.

Any costume alternations are the responsibility of each dancer's parent. While dancers are measured and costumes are order to their specifications, but are made to vary by 3 inches to fit a wider range of dancers. Please use your best judgement when getting costumes altered as we cannot replace or exchange costumes.

Recital Tickets will be available for purchase May 5th at the studio. Preorders are available now through the Google Form link available on BAND. Reminder each dancer gets one complimentary ticket.

Tickets are \$10 in advance and children 3 and under are free.

Rehearsal Information

Studio rehearsals May 27th-29th are Closed rehearsals. Only dancers and stage personnel are permitted in the studio during rehearsal. We will leave time for parent questions and review of the costume book for name spelling and accessories. Please make sure all dancers are dressed to dance with shoes and bags labeled, labeled water bottle and a small snack. Please no full meals, colored liquids or things that could easily be spilled. Parents will have to sign dancers out at the end of each rehearsal. We will be going over theater etiquette in class and during the first practice but all our Theater Rules are attached below.

- IF YOU CAN SEE THE AUDIENCE, THE AUDIENCE CAN SEE YOU
- LISTEN TO YOUR BACKSTAGE HELPERS
- DO NOT PEEK OUT THE CURTAIN OR TOUCH WINGS
- TAP STUDENTS, BRING SOCKS TO WEAR OVER TAP SHOES
