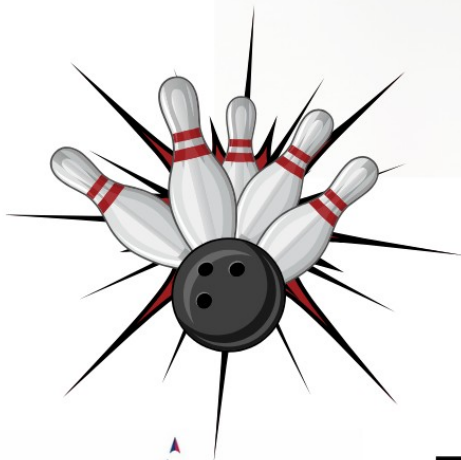

1: TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE - This is a handicapped tournament with handicap being 90% of 220. All final scores and prizes will be based on the bowlers scratch score plus handicap.

2: ELIGIBILITY - The tournament is open to USBC members. If you are from another association you may pay the association fees and participate in the tournament.

3: ENTERING AVERAGE - Participants average to be used in the following order;

(1) 2025-2026 composite average on Bowl.com.

(2) If no 25/26 average, then 24/25 composite average will be used.

(3) Highest current average of 21 games, as of the tournament cutoff date will be used if the bowler has no composite average.

(4) Finally, if none of the above are available, bowler will bowl scratch.

4: TARDY - Late bowlers must start in the frame being bowled with a zero given for the frames missed. Pacers are not permitted.

5: PROPER ATTIRE - Proper bowling attire shall be required to bowl, this includes no tank tops, halter tops or short shorts. T-shirts with offensive language or graphics

6: CHECK IN - All entrants must check in for event 1 hour prior to the start time

7: LANE ASSIGNMENTS - Lane Assignments shall be made by the tournament director

8: SIDE EVENTS - Side events will be offered if there are enough participants

9: ENTRY REFUSAL - The Martin County USBC Association shall reserve the right to refuse any entry

10: QUESTIONS/PROTESTS - The tournament director shall resolve all questions not covered by these rules. The tournament director shall reserve the right to hear and act on all protests concerning this tournament. The decision of the tournament director shall be final subject to any right to appeal under USBC Rule 329.

11: RE-RATING - The tournament director shall have the right to re-rate any bowler prior to entry.

Make checks payable to the Martin County USBC Association. Full name of entrant and all required information must be shown. All entries must be printed or typed. Submit entries to any Martin County USBC Board Member , either center Stuart Bowl or Jensen Beach Bowl.
