- d. Potential fundraisers After the Harvest Festival, we realized a need for portable lighting and a sound system, and a donor has stepped forward to help us fundraise for these items. We have started pricing and would like to plan something easy and creative, including asking local businesses to help us raise funds for these PTO items, to be used at upcoming events! If you have any ideas on where to purchase, or how to proceed, please let us know!
- e. Budget "line items" Planning where our money will go for maximum impact! We created a draft and will share it to get feedback!
- f. Snack packs update We heard about a need to transport the FELT "snack packs" to the school on behalf of the Myakka City Alliance and Meals on Wheels Plus of Manatee, and we managed to get a few amazing volunteers to help us keep the program going. Our PTO (and support team!) is the best!
- g. Teacher requests We've had a few teacher requests and we are happy to report that your PTO is excited to make dreams come true!
