8-Week Basic Farrier Education

This is an outline only. There is much more to be discussed in detail. Cases will be taken as they present themselves in class. Given that it is impossible in an 8-week program to work on every type of case one may encounter, all aspects contained below will be discussed via classroom instruction. **Much has changed in farrier education. It's more than just cutting off the long and nailing something onto the short. We will teach you to read a foot and think thru a protocol by developing a "feel", using the 5-Guidelines for Evaluating Hoof Health, Hoof-Mapping techniques, common sense, intuition, knowledge and your skill as it develops.**
