WHAT IS THE FFLA?

Once there were 8000 fire lookouts across the U.S., but now only 2500 remain. The Forest Fire Lookout Association (FFLA), founded in 1990, is an organization involved in research and promoting public awareness of current and former forest fire lookout sites. Members of the FFLA have been involved in the restoration of over 150 lookouts. Working with federal and state agencies, the FFLA maintains the National Historic Lookout Register (www.nhlr.org), and information about former fire lookout sites (www.fflos.com). The activities of 55 chapters or affiliated lookout support groups include historic research, maintenance, and much volunteer staffing.
