Gone are the days of polo wrapping the BEMER leg cuffs to your horse's neck and hoping they don't slide during the session.

Constructed with high-quality and durable materials, the **Horse Neck-Applicator** contains 12 coils strategically positioned to transmit the patented BEMER signal into the horse's neck, covering everything from the withers to the poll.



Several coils are located along the top of the applicator, allowing the signal to reach the horse's nuchal ligament. Found in the dorsal cervical region (along the top of the neck), the ligament aids in holding up and lowering the horse's head and neck. The ligament runs from the withers, along the crest of the neck, over the top of C1 (atlas) and C2 (axis) and attaches to the back of the skull. This area of C1, C2 and the skull attachment point form the horse's poll, which is a common spot for discomfort in horses either as its own issue or as a secondary result of compensating for pain or an injury elsewhere in the body.

Thanks to its perfect fit and intelligent strap system, the **Horse**Neck-Applicator can be quickly and perfectly adjusted to your horse.

The applicator is equipped with five straps to conveniently connect it

to your **Horse-Set** – two at the lower neck, two on the halter and one for attaching to the horse blanket. This prevents the **Horse Neck-Applicator** from slipping around the neck or over the ears.

The battery-powered signal controller is integrated into the **Horse Neck-Applicator**, allowing for a seamless transition into your daily barn routine.

The breathable mesh inserts in the **Horse Neck-Applicator** prevent excessive heating of the neck area, ensuring your beloved equine will feel comfortable during a session. The applicator is lightweight, weighing approximately 3.5 pounds, and won't put any burden on your horse's neck while using it.

The **Horse Neck-Applicator's** high-quality materials, impeccable craftsmanship and durable fabric will have your horse feeling comfortable, relaxed and ready for what's next, be it competition or trail riding.
