

PPMWS Restructuring And Dissolution Bullet Points to Be Discussed:

1. The PPMWS will continue to pay the \$100,000 annually.
2. The PPMWS will at the end of each fiscal year remit to CWA an amount equal to keeping the PPMWS revenue neutral. In determining the amount to remain revenue neutral, the then current fiscal years' income and, the then current fiscal years' expenses, as defined in number 3 of the Agreement signed July 2011, shall be used.
3. The PPMWS will contribute, at the end of each fiscal year, an amount equal to 10% of the same fiscal years' income as determined in number 3 above.
4. The PPMWS will strictly enforce the Sector Bylaws and CWA Convention and begin forced mergers of local unions, not in compliance with the Sector Bylaws and CWA Constitution, within 12-months. Such mergers will be in accordance with the PPMWS Bylaws and CWA Constitution.
5. The PPMWS President and Laws and Finance Committee will, no later than the end of budget year 2023, develop a dissolution/transition plan of the PPMWS. The CWA President will support such plan and recommend such CWA Constitutional changes as needed.
6. The CWA President agrees not to seek or recommend any special conventions or constitutional changes until the end of budget year 2023, and only in accordance with number 5 above.
7. These bullet points must be adopted by and recommended by the Laws and Finance Committee at the next PPMWS Sector Conference.
