Re: PPMWS Demand for Arbitration

Dear Attorney Shea:

As you know, the Print, Publishing and Media Workers Sector of the Communications Workers of America has been attempting to engage the dispute resolution procedure of the PPMWS agreement since April of 2018. The CWA has repeatedly and consistently obstructed the Sector's right to engage in dispute resolution.

Accordingly, I am enclosing a Complaint To Compel Arbitration, which will be filed in the United States District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania no later than August 20, 2018. If you desire to abide by the terms of the PPMWS agreement and mutually agree upon a third party neutral to arbitrate the dispute between PPMWS and CWA prior to August 20th, the Complaint will not be filed. Failure to live up to the terms of the Agreement will result in the initiation of legal action. I am hopeful for a meaningful response.
