# WEDNESDAY MORNING BIBLE STUDY

Wednesday morning's Bible study topic is entitled *God's People Grieve*. The Christian, like the unbeliever, is sure to suffer the loss of loved ones and to grieve. This is because "the wages of sin is death" (Romans 6:23) as Paul puts it. What's more, our inclination, much like the unbeliever, is to fight our loss and resist our time to grieve. The Christian, however, is permitted to engage in another fight, what the apostle calls the *good fight*. During this fight the believer may face the truth head on, recognizing that death is only a portal to eternal life. Existing side by side with our sorrow is joy, as we rejoice in our Savior's victory over sin and death.
