## Press Release

On June 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> the Dalai Lama will be speaking publicly at the University of California in San Diego and at commencement at UC San Diego. He will be speaking on “The Value of Education, Ethics and Compassion for the Well-Being of Self and Others” and “Embracing the Beauty of Diversity in Our World”.

However, he does not practice what he preaches. The Dalai Lama sanctions oppression, persecution and segregation throughout the Tibetan community. Additionally the Dalai Lama has misappropriated millions of dollars in donations to finance the publishing of discriminatory and demonizing propaganda.

We ask that the Dalai Lama agree to 7 basic points:

1. To allow anyone who wishes to practice Dorje Shugden the freedom to do so
2. To stop completely the discrimination against Shugden practitioners
3. To allow all Shugden monks and nuns who have been expelled to return to their monasteries and nunneries, and to receive the same material and spiritual rights as non-Shugden practitioners
4. To rebuild the Dorje Shugden statue that was demolished in Dharamsala (near Dalai Lama’s palace) on April 5th, 1996 and to replace all books, paintings and art that were also destroyed and prevent this from happening again.
5. To take back and apologize for false allegations and accusations and defamation towards the Shugden practitioners and stop attempting to rewrite history.
6. To compensate for emotional and physical distress as well as financial losses caused by segregation and discrimination and to share the funds provided by the international community withheld by the Dalai Lama from the Shugden Community since 2008.
7. To write to Tibetan communities throughout the world telling them that they should apply practically the above six points

The International Tibetan Shugden Community will be demonstrating at each of these venues. Please come and let us share the other side of the Dalai Lama with you.
