Hello everyone!

We are excited to have you all join us this weekend in Menifee, CA to celebrate our club's 4th anniversary back at the place where it all started. Below you will find the final confirmation and trial information for our “4th Annual Rat Jubilee” NASDA Trials.

*** This trial is full on Saturday & Sunday, there is limited room for day of entries on Friday. Move ups are always allowed. Please see us at the check in desk to make any move ups or add ons ***

We are in need of volunteers for this event. Volunteers help make the day run smoothly and keep us all happy. :) Please respond to this email if you are able to volunteer.

Directions & parking: Trial address is: 25190 Menifee Rd. Menifee, CA 92585.

IMPORTANT: Parking is on Patelli Way (just off Menifee Rd.) You will see a Trailed by 20 Hounds Banner in front of a gate, please park perpendicular to the wall so we can fit in as many cars as possible. There will be cones & signs designating where parking starts and ends. You may park on both sides of the street. Do not block any gates or driveways. Crating will be out of your car.

Please note this is a private residence, so please be respectful of the property. Do not arrive early, keep barking dog noise in the parking lot to a minimum, and please pick up all trash and potty bags.

Potty Area for dogs: You may potty your dogs anywhere on the cul-de-sac of Patelli way. Please refrain from allowing your dogs to potty inside the gates of the Collin's & Diaz's residence, as those will be search areas.

Weather: The weather will be very hot this weekend. Highs in the 90's with lots of sun. Be sure to bring shade cloths for your cars and fans, and plenty of water. There is no shade in the parking lots. There is room for pop up tents. If you bring a pop up tent make sure you bring weights to hold it down. The wind has been known to pick up unexpectedly here. We will have cooling pools set up for your dogs (or you) to cool off in.

Food: Trailed by 20 Hounds will be providing lunch all days for exhibitors. There will be sandwiches on Friday & Sunday and pizza will be served on Saturday. Snacks, water, seltzer, and diet soda will be available all days. There is no charge for lunch, however donations are greatly appreciated. A donation bin will be out on the snack table.

Scheduling: The scheduling below is to aide in estimating what time you will run. Please be sure to arrive at least 20+ min prior to your estimated start time to have a chance to potty your dog etc. We will not be able to hold a class if you are not at the facility before the class ends. There will be dogs who finish a course in a matter of seconds while other dogs may use full course time, this is why it's very hard to predict.

All days:

7:30AM - Exhibitors may start arriving & check in at our front desk to verify we have you entered in the correct classes. Please DO NOT arrive early.

7:50AM - Handler briefing

8:00AM - Classes Start running in the following order. Note courses will be set so that exhibitors will run both trials for the day back to back unless otherwise notated. Class conflicts will be addresses at the briefing.

*** Lunch break will be taken around 1:30pm. All classes will pause at that time and resume after the lunch break ends ***

Move Ups: Move Ups are welcome at our event. If your dog earns their title and you wish to move up, please let the judge know. If your dog has moved up prior to this event, please let us know now or at check in, so we can adjust your entries. You can check your dogs current points on the dashboard prior to coming to the event to be sure how many points you need for your next title!

Scoring: Our trial secretary will enter the scores after each class ends and post the results at the check in table. Please see the club member at the check in table to pick up any Q, BOB, HIT, or title ribbons. Preliminary results will also be emailed to all exhibitors early next week. Be sure to check the preliminary results and let us know right away if you notice any discrepancies. It's much easier to correct them before they are submitted to NASDA.

Fun Stuff:

SPECIAL AWARDS- We will recognize the team that qualified with the least amount of time remaining with our "Terrapin award" each day.

PHOTOS- Play Paws Record Video & Photo will be providing their photography services to exhibitors all weekend. If you are interested in having photos taken of your dog running please check in with them at their booth in the morning. They will only be taking action shots upon request. They will also have a special photo booth available on site for you to pose for photos with your dogs and ribbons to commemorate your experience. One quick picture in their photo booth and you'll receive a souvenir photo via email within 48 hours.

We will also have a NQ raffle for this weekend. Every NQ you get gives you an entry into the raffle. Winner will be drawn at the end of the day on Sunday. You do not need to be present to win.
