The Makery partners with The Arc Otsego, Springbrook, Pathfinder Village, and key stakeholders, including SUNY Oneonta, Hartwick College, SUNY Delhi, SUNY Cobleskill, and Cornell University.

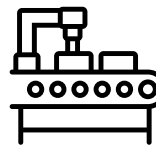

### Food Co-Manufacturing



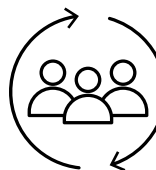
Scalable co-packing solutions for startup brands, allowing small businesses to produce at volume without high overhead costs.
