## AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING ON CORNERS, ON THE STREETS AND SIDES OF STREETS DURING ROAD REPAIRS AND DURING SNOW REMOVAL.

Be it Ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Burlington Junction, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1: Obstructing View at Corners. It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle near any intersection where such vehicle constitutes and obstruction of traffic. Vehicles must park at a minimum of 20 feet from the intersection.

Section 2: Snow Removal. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on any portion of the roadway during times of snow removal. Roadway is defined as that portion of a street that City improved, designed, or ordinarily used for vehicular travel, including the shoulder. Snow removal will be in effect with an accumulation of 2 inches.

Section 3: Cleaning Sidewalks. All persons are hereby required to keep the sidewalks in front of, or adjacent to, the property or premises owned or occupied by them under their control, within the city, clear and free from rubbish, filth, refuse, dirt, snow, ice, from any and all obstructions.

Section 3: Street Maintenance: During the times of street maintenance no one shall park any vehicle on the street so that proper repairs can be made.

Section 4: Removal, Impounding and Return of Vehicles. The Mayor, any Councilman, or the Foreman may determine if any vehicle is in violation of the sections listed above and may call to have the vehicle towed. Owner of vehicle will be responsible for paying the towing fee and any fines.

Section 5: Violation. Violation of the Ordinance shall be deemed a misdemeanor and the person may be fined up to Five Hundred (\$500.00), receive a jail sentence of up to ninety (90) days, or receive both such fine and jail sentence.
