On May 17th, about 250 Lutherans from the Southeastern Iowa Synod gathered in Des Moines for the annual Synod Assembly. Synod Assembly acts as an annual meeting for the Synod where church business is discussed and votes are cast for constitutional changes, budgets, and more. But it is also a time full of worship and connection. This year, the theme of Synod Assembly was, "Spirit Open Our Hearts," based on Hebrews 10:11-25. During each of our worship sessions, we sang the hymn, "Spirit, Open My Heart," from our hymnal, All Creation Sings. This hymn calls upon the Holy Spirit to open our hearts to all the good and bad that comes with being alive, to replace our stony hearts with one that is kind and tender. To love as God loves. The final verse reads, "As I live from day to day, love will be my finest labor." This hymn is one that cracks open my own heart. We sang it as the Hymn of the Day at both our seminary baccalaureate service and at our wedding. I find the words to be honest and extremely hopeful. Our goal as disciples is to carry the love of Christ in our hearts and to extend it to others. To pay attention to the way that the Spirit is moving in us and around us. This is no easy task, but we are never doing it alone. May this refrain echo through us as a prayer, confession, and promise.



Quilt & Lap Robes Update




A big thank you to everyone and our confirmation youth who helped at FLCW sewing days.

Pastors Katie and Eric Jensen will be leading the Thresher's Ecumenical Worship on Sunday, July 13th at the Miles Park.


