
# Faith Notes

When I was growing up and going through grade school, I remember that we started every class by reciting the pledge of allegiance together. However, as I got older even though I could say this pledge by memory every day, I realized that I didn't fully understand the meaning of what I was saying. I think something similar happens with the Lord's Prayer and the Ecumenical Creeds of the Church (The Apostles Creed, Nicene-Constantinopolitan Creed, and Athanasian Creed). Where even though we recite these words on a weekly

basis, we may not fully understand their meaning. Something I did with the confirmation students this past year to try and gain a better understanding of these words was to have them paraphrase the Creeds and the Lord's Prayer in their own words. With their permission, I am sharing what they wrote with all of you below. As you read these words, I hope you'll reflect on the meaning behind these words we say each week and if you feel it will help you, I encourage you to write your own paraphrases of the Creeds and Lord's Prayer.

### 2020 Confirmation Creed Paraphrase

"We trust in God, the King. Maker of all that we understand and don't understand. We trust in one ruler, God the Son, Jesus Christ. Birthed by a virgin. He was executed by murder. 3 days later he was revived. He is equal to the Father. He is the one and only decider. His reign will have no end. He is both truly human and truly God. We have faith in God the Holy Spirit. The world-wide church, the community of God's people. The forgiveness of anything that separates us from God's love, and the revival of everyone. We believe in the original follower's church and we trust in one baptism. The Holy Spirit is praised. The Holy Spirit gives us life, faith and inspired the prophets of the church. We trust in God's future. Amen, let it be so."

# 2020 Confirmation Lord's Prayer Paraphrase

"Holy God in heaven, respecting your name. All of existence is yours. May your commands and instructions be done, as on earth as they are in heaven. Give us our daily needs and communion. Forgive us when we hurt or harm our neighbors, as we strive to forgive our neighbors who hurt or harm us. Be with us in hardships. For yours is the kingdom, the power, and the glory. Amen, yes, yes."
