Rachel is receiving the donation collected from our summer noisy bucket and VBS offerings. We are happy to have her with us!

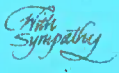


Youth currently in 8th-12th grade are invited to attend a Youth Gathering informational meeting on Wednesday, September 23rd at 6:30pm here at the church.
