Our Sunday School classes have been diving into prayer! We have had several discussions on how to pray and learning how to identify what children might want to pray for within their own lives. It is a consistent effort to familiarize and build confidence praying. However, we are making strides!

As you may have noticed, we do have a few of those simple, effective prayer petitions being added to the worship service, during the Prayers of the People. They are utilizing the simple format that includes two parts; the first is an acknowledgment of a blessing (or a "Thank you for...") and the second is for a special request or concern that is on your heart. An example could be: "Thanks for the gift of knowledge and love you have given the medical community. We ask for you to watch over those facing surgery and for quick recoveries."

It would be the education committee's goal to not only educate our students at Faith Lutheran about prayer, but also our congregational members! Aren't we all students of the word and children of God? We are hoping to get involvement from YOU!! We encourage everyone to submit a prayer in the box in the entryway. Again, our hope is that these are simple requests to be made to God. They do not need to be specific (preferably no names etc.), however they can be!

If you are struggling to find inspiration for prayers or if you just need a reminder of what each paragraph of the prayers of the people include, here is a reference as a little reminder of what the "topics" mentioned during the prayers are according to our red hymnal ELW, page 127.

Prayers reflect the wideness of God's mercy for the whole world-For the church universal, its ministry, and the mission of the gospel; For the well-being of creation;

For peace and justice in the world, the nations and those in authority, the community;

For the poor, oppressed, sick, bereaved, lonely; For all who suffer in body, mind, or spirit; For the congregation, and for special concern. Additional prayers may come from the assembly.

Wouldn't it be nice to know what others are praying for so we can include them in our prayers too?

### **Council Update**

At the Annual Meeting on January 19<sup>th</sup>, the congregation approved the recommendation of the Call Committee and the Church Council to extend a call to Katie Jensen. The compensation package has been signed by the synod office. After we sign the compensation package it will go to Katie. We are waiting on the formal letter of call from the Synod office. We will need to sign this document also and send it to Katie. Once Katie receives the Call Letter, she will have 30 days to accept the call.
