In 1988, the Charity and Hope circles decided to combine, hold evening bible studies, and then reorganized as the "Sharing Circle".


In 1991, the Grace and Loyalty circles combined and the "Caring Circle" was born.


FLCW is looking forward to presenting a short program during fellowship brunch to celebrate these 75 years of faith and service.
