
We are planning to hold our rummage sale



If you do not show, FSC has the right to charge you for the meal. As with all the meals, they are homemade and shopped for fresh each week. We are hoping if the weather stays nice, we may be able to set up some tables so if you would like to stay and eat outside, the option is available to you. Of course, safe distancing and precautions need to be enforced.

With all of the renovations hopefully coming to a close in Sept., we are attempting some normalcy starting in the middle of October.

We will have a full plan in place, filed with the county for your and the staffs protection. The document will be posted for viewing. Masks are required to be worn while in the building unless you are 6 feet apart from any other members. Temperatures will be taken upon arrival and you will need to alert the staff if you have any symptoms of any kind, have been exposed to someone with Covid 19 or traveled in a Covid area that requires quarantining upon re-entering NYS.

Our programming, meal program and events are going to look a bit different in the future. We are only allowed a certain number in the building so you are *REQUIRED to sign up for any programs you wish to take part in*. If you can not make something you signed up for, you **MUST** call to cancel or, in case of a meal or a program that has a cost, you *will be charged* for it.

Let's start out small and see how we do. I know everyone has had a hard time with everything shut down the last few months so, let's not push ourselves too fast but know we are still here for you in whatever capacity we can be.
