## **The Memory Tree**

The Fayetteville Senior Center invites the community to share in the 41st (virtual) lighting of the Memory Tree on Friday, November 27, 2020 in the heart of the Village of Fayetteville.

In 1979, village resident Doris Baldwin conceived the notion of a seasonal tree illumination with blue bulbs to represent the hue of the forget-me-not flower. Each bulb is lit to represent the memory of a cherished loved one, or to give support, love, and honor to those who are still with us.

This tradition has been able to continue on thanks to Ruth Wood. In 1999 after the Labor Day Storm uprooted the tree, it was Ruth's idea (and expense) to replace it with another 20ft tree. The evergreen next to the Fayetteville Fire Station is illuminated in stages as the donations grow, sparkling first at the village Tree Lighting Celebration the Friday evening after Thanksgiving. Through the years, due to the efforts of many, this has become an important fundraiser for the Fayetteville Senior Center. The Fayetteville Senior Center serves its members in many ways, contributing to their social well being, their productivity health and continuing education. ## The Kitchen is still closed for renovations

The renovations have delayed the opening of the building, specifically the kitchen. We can not open until the building is complete, safe and sanitized. We also need approval from various inspectors. Therefore we do not have an opening date currently set.

When we reopen we will have a full plan in place, filed with the county for your and the staffs protection. The document will be posted for viewing. Masks are required to be worn while in the building. You must remain 6 feet apart from any other members. Temperatures will be taken upon arrival and you will need to alert the staff if you have

symptoms of any kind. In addition you will be asked a few questions for Covid-19 evaluation. You will also need to sign in with phone number for contact tracing purposes.

Our programming, meal program and events are going to look a bit different in the future. We are only allowed a certain number people in the building so you will be *REQUIRED to sign up for any programs you wish to take part in*. If you can not make something you signed up for, you MUST call to cancel or, in case of a meal or a program that has a cost, you *will be charged* for it.

We know everyone has had a hard time with everything being shut down the last few months and we have missed you terribly. We are still here for you in whatever capacity we can be. Please do not hesitate to call.


# MEMORIALS
