The Fayetteville Senior Center is a community based not- for-profit organization dedicated to improving, enhancing, and educating the lives of older adults in our community. Participation in the organization's programs is subject to the observance of the Center's rules and procedures. **The activities outlined below are strictly prohibited.** Any Member or Staff member who violates this code is subject to discipline, up to and including removal from the program.

- ❖ Not following Covid 19/Variant rules and procedures established at the center
- ❖ Abusive language towards a staff member, volunteer or member
- ❖ Discourtesy or rudeness to a fellow member, staff member or volunteer
- ❖ Actual or threatened violence toward any group or individual
- ❖ Failure to follow an agency policy or procedure
- ❖ Bullying or taking unfair advantage of any member, staff member or volunteer
- ❖ Abuse of the physical center, its contents, other members property or theft of any kind
- ❖ Use of the building for personal purposes during business or after hours without the pre authorization of the Director
- ❖ Confronting staff in an argumentative or unprofessional manor, is **strictly prohibited**
