1442/2021 Eid celebration in Toowoomba on 13 May

Following the announcement of Grand Mufti of Australia, Muslims in Toowoomba celebrated Eid ul Fitr 1442/2021 on Thursday, 13 May 2021. Since the Eid was on a weekday, we did not get any rental hall for Eid prayers. At the end, we had to offer Eid prayers in our current prayer hall in the Mosque premises. To avoid large gathering in the small hall, we divided the community in two groups – one praying at 6:45am and the other at 7:30am.

Unlike last year, we were lucky to have physical Eid prayers. Alhamdulillah, the prayer hall was overfull in each session. Women and children join the community to participate the Eid prayers. Br Omar AlSakit led the first session and Br Abdu Mohamed led the second session of the prayers. People from as far away as Kingaroy and Warwick came to Toowoomba for Eid prayers.

With the completion of the Second Stage contracted job, the reconstruction of Toowoomba Mosque project is about to enter its Final Stage. The Second Stage job was all internal fittings including plumbing, electrical, Gyproc, aircon, painting etc. We still need to complete Mehrab area and some final paining before laying the carpet.

The Final Stage work will include 56 carparking places, two driveways, one retaining wall, on ramp, two acoustic wall, stormwater management, landscaping and concreting around the building. We are looking for contractors, builders or tradies to get quotations for all these works. Any help will be highly appreciated.

Visa Application for the new Imam

Toowoomba Islamic Charitable Trust has launched a Labour-Agreement application with the Department of Immigration to get visa for the new Imam of Garden City Mosque. With the help of Professor Shahjahan Khan and Associate Professor Mainul Islam, Mr Albab Khan has prepared all documentations and submitted online application for the Labour-Agreement in early April 2021.

Professor Khan has contacted Federal MP, Hon Garth Hamilton and Ms Lisa Crawford, Director of Home Affairs, seeking their support to speed up the visa application processing for the new Imam.

Here is a brief summary of his letter:

On behalf of the Toowoomba Islamic Charitable Trust and Islamic Society of Toowoomba, I am writing this letter to seek your assistance to speed up the processing of our application for labour-agreement submitted to the Department of Home Affairs to enable our newly appointed Imam (Religious Worker) to join his duties in Toowoomba as a matter of urgency.

Our full time Imam of the Garden City (Toowoomba) Mosque has moved to another job effective from 31/03/2021 with a very short notice. As a result, the community has been put under severe pressure in trying to maintain the operations of the mosque without a full-time Imam. We need an Imam urgently.

For the interim, we have allocated certain responsibilities to some volunteers of the community to maintain only the basic services at a very limited scale. Without a full time paid Imam it is impossible to run the daily five times prayers, madrasa (Islamic/Arabic learning classes), counselling, weekly sermons, engaging with wider and diverse communities and essential community support services such as helping victims of DV and youth activities.

On behalf of the Muslims in Toowoomba, I request you kindly to approach the Department of Home Affairs to explain the time sensitiveness of this labour-agreement and the urgency of our community so that they may process the agreement application at the shortest possible time.
