Visit by Hon Tony Burke MP

On 4 March 2025, the Garden City Mosque was honoured to welcome the Hon Tony Burke MP, Minister for Home Affairs, Leader of the House, and Federal Member for Watson. Minister Burke was warmly received by the Islamic Society of Toowoomba's President Assoc. Prof. Mainul Islam and Imam Dr Mohammad Aminul Islam Azhari, along with community members.



During the visit, Minister Burke became the first official guest to sign the mosque's newly commissioned guestbook, which chronicles the history of Muslims in Toowoomba. He also unveiled a commemorative plaque and was presented with a special rededication coin minted in 2023 to mark the rebuilding of the mosque following the arson attacks in 2015. The visit was a symbol of continued government engagement and mutual respect.

Short Tafsir Sessions After Fajr


