Solidarity gathering for Afghan people

Muslims in Toowoomba organised a solidarity gathering of the community in support of the people of Afghanistan. A large number of members of Toowoomba community joined the gathering to support the oppressed people of Afghanistan at the Toowoomba Mosque at 3:00pm on Sunday, 22 August 2021.

Alhamdulillah, many members of the wider community joined the Muslims in the Toowoomba Mosque to express their support and sympathy for the oppressed people of Afghanistan. We explained Islamic position on women and how Prophet Muhammad SWS returned good behaviour in response to abuse and misbehaviour. Among the speakers were Catholic Bishop Robert McGuckin, Dr Mark Copland, Ms Gen Allpass, Sq George Helon, Mr Phil Armit, and from the local Afghans Dr Ataullah Shinwarie, Mr Nasir Haiderzai, and Ms Bibi Zainab Khogyani. Apologies were received from Hon Garth Hamilton MP, Federal Member for Groom (Toowoomba); Professor Geraldine Mackenzie, Vice Chancellor of University of Southern Queensland; and Hon David Janetzki MP, State Member for Toowoomba South.

At the end everyone joined the duwa/supplication led by Professor Shahjahan Khan. May Allah respond to the verse of the Qur'an below reflecting the urge of the people of Afghanistan: An-Nisa (The Women) - 4:75

الظَّالِمِ الْقَرْيَةِ هَذِهِ مِنْ أَخْرِجْنَا رَبَّنَا يَقُولُونَ الَّذِينَ وَالْوِلْدَانِ وَالنِّسَاء الرِّجَالِ مِنَ وَالْمُسْتَضْعُفِينَ اللهِ سَبِيلِ فِي ثُقَاتِلُونَ لاَ لَكُمْ وَمَا نَصِيرًا الْمُنْكَ مِن لَنَا وَاجْعَل وَلِيًّا لَّمُنْكَ مِن لَنَا وَاجْعَل أَهْلَهَا

And how could you refuse to fight in the cause of God and of the utterly helpless men and women and children who are crying, "O our Sustainer! Lead us forth [to freedom] out of this land whose people are oppressors, and raise for us, out of Thy grace, a protector, and raise for us, out of Thy grace, one who will bring us succour!"

The meeting endorsed an application of a Toowoomba resident Mr Phil Armit to the Prime Minister and other relevant Ministers of Australia asking the following:

We the undersigned citizens of Toowoomba, call on the government to

- intensify its efforts to evacuate Australian citizens and Afghans who have worked for Australia as
 direct employees or as contractors, who, as a result of their association face a clear risk to their
 safety;
- broaden its rescue efforts to include people who face certain persecution and probable death at the hands of the Taliban because they belong to an ethnic minority; and

 approach the new Afghan government to seek negotiations to effect on-going evacuation of these at-risk people

As citizens of a city which has a strong record of resettling refugees, we also ask that

• the government provide, as a matter of urgency, opportunities for all Afghans who are already living in Australia to bring their families here to join them.

In the past when the world was confronted by such crises, we acted swiftly and decisively to bring humanitarian refugees to Australia. We did the right and honourable thing at those times and Toowoomba more than played its part. We ask you to do the same at this crucial moment in history.

Toowoomba unites to help Afghan families fleeing the Taliban

Images of desperate refugees flooding the Kabul Airport play on repeat on the television, but a small group of Toowoomba residents have decided to act, to help families in the Taliban's firing line.

As the world comes to grips with the frantic scenes of Afghan families fleeing ahead of the Taliban's advance, the Toowoomba Muslim community wants to help.



Islamic Society president Professor Shahjahan Khan has launched an appeal and asked the wider community to contribute.

"Within the community we are talking with our brothers and sisters who are still in Afghanistan to offer our sympathy and support," he said.

Part of the money raised through the appeal will go to international aid organisations, like the Red Crescent, to provide emergency food, shelter and medicine within Afghanistan.

The rest will be distributed to Afghan refugees living in Toowoomba so they can send it directly to their families back home.

"They are very shocked that it all fell apart so quickly," Prof Khan said.

"They are worried because their families are not leaving their homes for fear of being attacked or having their homes looted.

"They can still communicate with their relatives in Afghanistan so they are very stressed."

Professor Dr Shahjahan Khan has launched an appeal to support families fleeing the advance of Afghan forces.

Afghanistan has descended into chaos after the US, Australian

and coalition forces started their withdrawal from the county in March. This led to the rapid advance of

Taliban forces who claimed the capital – Kabul – at the weekend. It signalled a despairing end to the 20 year occupation that was launched to oust the repressive government.

Prof Khan said there was a series of failings that led to the humanitarian crisis

"We were hoping something would happen in Qatar peace talks, for a peaceful transition of power but it is very unfortunate that this did not happen," he said.

"Then the president (Ashraf Ghani) left the country and that was another unexpected thing.



"I would have thought the government would work with the Taliban to rebuild Afghanistan."

(Photo by Wakil Kohsar / AFP). Afghans have suffered through more than 50 years of conflict that started with the Soviet Invasion in 1979. Prof Khan said he held out slim hope that the Afghan people could finally find peace.

"In this chaos we have seen many people lose their lives but we have not seen any large scale massacres," he said

"The people within the Taliban who have the upper hand appear to have the respect for life, they appear to be respecting the lives of their people.

"We hope that will further strengthen their position as future leaders of their country."
