

As winter sets in, the plight of Gaza's children has worsened. They are cold, wet, and barefoot, many still wearing summer clothes. Without cooking gas, families are scavenging for plastic scraps to burn for warmth. Diseases are spreading rapidly, exacerbated by the lack of medicine, medical supplies, and doctors.

Hospitals are overwhelmed, operating under near-total electricity blackouts and relying on minimal fuel supplies for survival.

The children of Gaza desperately need our *duas* and donations. The Islamic Society of Toowoomba (ISOT) is raising funds to provide vital support for these children during the harsh winter.
