

WHAT'S NEW IN 2026

Team Forms

After the inaugural exhibition of Team Forms at the Dragons Way: Fists of Fury tournament, we decided to add the category to Fall Brawl. This division offers an opportunity for 2 to 4 competitors to work in tandem to demonstrate technical precision, timing, and the unified execution of their respective martial arts disciplines.

Partner Forms is not a point-sanctioned event for the 2026 season.

You are welcome and encouraged to show off your team's skills in this event, but points will not be earned for either the Warriors United or Dragons Way tournament circuits based on your results.

This event starts at **9:00am on Saturday**. Cost is \$5/competitor and is paid in addition to pre-registration packages (like Friday night events).

Forms & Weapons Division Options

Weapons & Open-Hand Forms competitors will choose one category that best suits their form: Traditional or Open/Extreme. This separation will allow a more equitable breakdown of skill sets and appropriately matched competition. Points will still be tracked under the Weapons event or Forms event in their circuit regardless of the category you choose to compete in.

Choose Open/Extreme if: your form features gymnastic, highly athletic moves, weapons releases, or variations from traditional formats.

Choose Traditional if: your form strictly adheres to classical mechanics (of a weapon), focuses on solid stances, power, and precise strikes.

Registration Tables

Doors open at 7:30am on Saturday to begin registration & check-in.
Registration tables will close at 11am.

Friday night doors open at 5pm with registration tables closing at 6pm.

It is the responsibility of the competitor to arrive in time for their events. Tournament director is not obligated to postpone any events while waiting for competitors.

Breaking Division Options

Breaking competitors will be split up into Traditional or Smash Breaking based on the total number of boards in your breaking routine. This separation will allow a more equitable breakdown of skill sets and appropriately matched competition. Points will still be tracked under the Breaking event in the circuit regardless of which category you are placed in. Max number of boards for a competitor has been capped based on age for safety and efficiency at the event.

Traditional Breaking: you are breaking less than the minimum number of boards for the Smash breaking division for your age (see chart).

Smash Breaking: the total number of boards in your routine falls within the Smash breaking requirements for your age (see chart).

Ages 7 - 8	3/8"	8 - 14 boards
Ages 9 - 10	1/2"	9 - 16 boards
Ages 11 - 12	1/2"	10 - 18 boards
Ages 13 - 14	3/4"	11 - 20 boards
Ages 15 - 17	3/4"	12 - 22 boards
Ages 18 & up	3/4"	13 - 24 boards
