Thursday, September 19th, 11am

Practice

Show up at 11am, Practice will start around 12pm. We will have a quick shooters meeting and decide on shooters needs and which distances we'll shoot for practice. It will take a little effort to get squadded so please be on time if you plan to participate.

Match #2 is 10 shots @ 1000 yards

Match #3 is 10 shots @ 1000 yards

Match #4 is aggregate total of Match #1, #2 and #3

Saturday, September 21st, 8am

**BPTRA Creedmoor Match, LR-45 Course of Fire
Traditional Shooter/Spotter Team Match**

Match #5 is 15 shots @ 800 Yards

Match #6 is 15 shots @ 900 Yards

Match #7 is 15 shots @ 1000 Yards

Match #8 is the aggregate of Match #1, #2 and #3

Sunday, September 22nd, 8am

**BPTRA Midrange Match, BPTRA MR-500 Course of Fire
Traditional Shooter/Spotter Team Match**

Match #9 is 10 shots @ 300 Yards

Match #10 is 10 shots @ 500 Yards

Match #11 is 10 shots @ 600 Yards

Match #12 is the aggregate of Match #9, Match #10 and Match #11

Grand Aggregate

Match #13 is the aggregate of Match #4, Match #8 and Match #12

The high aggregate of Match #13 is our BPTRA Championships, Grand Champion.

Note: For 2019 the Money Match is included in the Grand Aggregate of events.

Rules

BPTRA rules for each course of fire will govern BPTRA Championships unless posted otherwise by the Match Director.

Entries

All entries and payment must be received by September 1st, no exceptions.
Please send your entries in as early as possible for the planning of the meal, target prep and match.

Squadding and Scoring

Squadding for the Money Match will be in groups of 3. Squadding for all other matches will be in groups of 4. All competitors will be expected to spot and score for their shooter. All competitors must inform their scorekeeper when going for score. All competitors will be responsible for pulling targets and pit duty unless otherwise arranged with the Match Director.

Jury

A jury of 3 entered competitors will be picked by the Match Director. The Jury will act and make decisions in accordance with BPTRA Rules.

Shooters Meeting and Scores

There will be a shooters meeting every day after each match is over and scores have been posted. After scores are posted and competitors who are present have been informed, you will have 15 minutes to protest or until all competitors state they are satisfied.

Awards

Awards will be based upon number of competitors overall and in each class and category. The Match Director will determine if there are enough entries in each to warrant an award or awards.

- Certificates will be given for daily awarded categories.
- The Buffalo Trophy will be awarded for one year to the Money Match Winner and must be returned by match time the next year. Winner takes 50% of the pot, 2nd place 20%, 3rd place 10%. 20% goes to CRC.
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall will be awarded in the aggregate of each days match.
- High Spotter will be awarded in the aggregate of each match.
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd will receive a trophy in the grand aggregate on Sunday.
- High Spotter will also receive a trophy in the grand aggregate on Sunday.

Dinner

Your entry includes a BBQ Dinner for shooters approximately 1-2 hours after shooting is complete on Saturday's Match. Any extra meal will be 10 dollars added to your entry fee.
Drinks not included, so bring BYOD.

Prizes

Must be present to win.

Accommodations

Camping is free on the range

Limited first come, first serve for RV spaces that have electrical hookups. Access costs \$5 and you can include this in your entry fee or pay separately.

There is water available at the Ranch House on the CRC Property.
