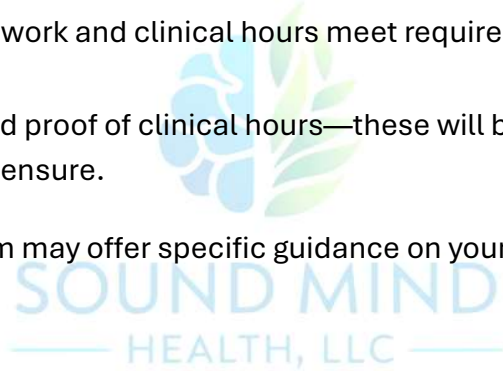
Step-by-Step Path to Becoming a PMHNP-BC

Transitioning from graduate student to board-certified Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner (PMHNP-BC) requires a clear, organized process. Follow these steps to ensure success.

Step 1: Graduate from an Accredited PMHNP Program

- Complete an accredited master's or doctoral-level PMHNP program.
- Ensure your coursework and clinical hours meet requirements for board certification.
- Save transcripts and proof of clinical hours—these will be required during certification and licensure.

Tip: Your graduate program may offer specific guidance on your state's licensure process. Always start there.



Step 2: Apply for Board Certification with ANCC

The **American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC)** offers the PMHNP-BC credential. You may apply once your program confirms completion of all requirements.

What You'll Need:

- Official transcripts (sent directly from your program)
- Proof of clinical hours
- Valid, unencumbered RN license
- Government-issued ID

Step 3: Schedule and Pass the ANCC PMHNP Certification Exam

- The ANCC exam includes 175 questions (150 scored, 25 pretest).
- Major content areas:
 - Scientific Foundations
 - Advanced Practice and Clinical Management
 - Psychotherapy and Medication
 - Legal and Ethical Principles

Step 4: Apply for Licensure as a PMHNP with Your State Board of Nursing

Once certified, apply for APRN licensure in your state.

Typical State Requirements:

- Proof of ANCC certification
- Application and licensure fees
- Criminal background check/fingerprinting
- RN license verification
- Additional paperwork for prescriptive authority (varies by state)

Tip: Each state’s process and timeline can vary significantly—apply early and follow all instructions carefully.

* Steps 5 through 7 are often initiated or supported by your employer once you begin your new role.

Step 5: Register for a National Provider Identifier (NPI)

An NPI is a 10-digit number required for billing and provider identification.

Apply for your NPI through the National Plan and Provider Enumeration System (NPPES):

You'll need:

- Your SSN or EIN (if applying under a business)
- PMHNP certification details
- Practice or mailing address

Tip: Use your personal name unless you're already operating under a registered business with its own EIN.

Step 6: Apply for a DEA Registration (If Prescribing Controlled Substances)

Once your state grants prescriptive authority, you can apply for your DEA number.

Step 7: Enroll in PECOS for Medicare and Medicaid Billing

To bill federal payers, enroll in:

- **PECOS** for Medicare: <https://pecos.cms.hhs.gov>
- **State Medicaid:** Each state has its own process—check your state's Medicaid website or portal.

After Certification: Save Your Receipts—Many Employers Reimburse Licensing Costs

Tip: Once hired, many healthcare organizations will reimburse or cover costs for:

- DEA registration
- NPI and PECOS setup
- State licensing fees
- Continuing education and ANCC renewal

Ask your recruiter or HR team during onboarding.
