

## **ENDURANCE RIDE WAIVER AND RELEASE**

**NOVEMBER 4-7, 2021**

As a participant in the “Autumn Gallop Benefit for Camp Boggy Creek Endurance Ride” to be held November 4-7, 2021 (the “Event”), and understand that The Boggy Creek Gang, Inc. (“Camp Boggy Creek”) permits use of certain specified areas of the camp lands and camp facilities, but does not organize or manage the Event. I am at least 18 years of age (or if not 18 years of age or older the undersigned is the guardian of the below named minor participant, and on such minor’s behalf), and agree to abide by the rules of AERC, SEDRA, SERA, Forestry, and the Event’s other organizers and managers (collectively, the “Organizers”), and understand that endurance riding involves being in remote areas for extended periods of time, far from communications, transportation, and medical facilities; that these areas have many natural and man-made hazards, which ride management cannot anticipate, identify, modify, or eliminate; that horses can be excitable, difficult to control, and unpredictable; and that accidents can happen to anyone at any time.

In consideration for being permitted to participate in this Event to support Camp Boggy Creek, I agree to take full responsibility for myself and the animal I am riding and hereby assume all risks and agree to release, hold harmless and covenant not to sue Camp Boggy Creek, its directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives, contractors, volunteers, sponsors, donors, supporters, and members (collectively, "the Releasees"), from any losses, claims, demands, causes of action, or liabilities for death, bodily injury or property damage that I may incur or have, or which may hereafter accrue to me, arising from, or in any manner connected with, or as a result of, my participation in and training for this Event, whether caused by negligence or carelessness of the Releasees or otherwise, from dangerous or defective property, animals or equipment owned, maintained, controlled, or provided by them or others, or because of the possible liability without fault (collectively, the “Claims”). I will hold harmless the ride organizers and management, all ride personnel and all property owners over whose land the ride crosses blameless for any accident, injury, or loss that might occur due to my participation in the Autumn Gallop Benefit for Camp Boggy Creek endurance ride and hold all free from all liability for injury or loss.

I acknowledge and understand that Camp Boggy Creek will not provide any cleaning services or sanitation of any of the camp facilities, such as lodges, cabins, equestrian facilities, showers, or any restrooms used during the event. The Event Organizers will be responsible for supplying such services and supplies as well as instructing participants about cleaning and sanitation.

I acknowledge and understand that Camp Boggy Creek will not be responsible for assigning any Autumn Gallop participants, volunteers, vendors, partners, sponsors or guests to use any lodging facilities, communal sleeping areas, communal showers or restrooms. The Event Organizers will have sole responsibility for overseeing and assigning any participants who wish to utilize the designated facilities.

Medical Release: Because COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is spread by person-to-person contact, I acknowledge and understand that neither the Organizers nor Camp Boggy Creek can guarantee that Autumn Gallop participants, volunteers, partners, vendors, sponsors, guests or others in attendance at the Event will avoid becoming exposed or infected with COVID-19. I certify that I am medically able to participate in, and perform the Event, and am in good health, and I am properly trained. I further agree to abide by the Organizer's "COVID-19 GUIDELINE AGREEMENT", a copy of which is attached to this Waiver and Release and abide by the Center for Disease Control's (CDC) recommendations for the prevention of the spread of the 2019 Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) and other communicable diseases, and I attest to having read the CDC's guidance at:

I understand Camp Boggy Creek will neither provide or arrange for medical personnel to be present or available during the Event; however, if I am unable to give informed consent at any time during the Event due to my mental or physical condition, or otherwise, while participating in the Event, I give consent to medical personnel for, and will be financially responsible for, emergency medical treatment for myself and my animal(s).

**Organizer's COVID 19 Guideline Agreement**

**COVID-19 GUIDELINE AGREEMENT**

IMPORTANT – Please do not attend if showing signs of illness to include, but not limited to, fever, cough, chills, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or loss of sense of smell and/or taste.

- Masks will be required in any Camp Boggy Building any area of congestion even if outside which could include: while checking in, vetting in/out or anytime you are away from your campsite. All areas where lines could form (I e, barn, covered arena, vetting) will be monitored to ensure Social Distancing is being respected. PLEASE SPREAD OUT.
- Dinner will not be served this year. However, on ride day grilled cheese (Get it and Go sandwiches will be available to riders and volunteers).
- There will be a riders meeting in the covered arena with everyone bringing their own chairs and spreading out to observe social distancing.
- All horses will be presented to the vet by only one handler. If a crew person is required to present the horse, the rider must step away to allow for proper distancing. (REMEMBER TO WEAR YOUR MASK WHILE PRESENTING YOUR HORSE)
- Awards will be given out at a specified time in the covered arena with everyone in attendance being respectful of social distancing.
- Ride management will provide hand sanitizer in common areas but it is each person's responsibility to take care of themselves. Bathrooms will have soap and water and/or hand sanitizer and riders are encouraged to wash hands whenever possible. Bathrooms will also be equipped with Clorox wet wipes. Everyone is encouraged to clean up after themselves.
- REMINDER this venue is a camp for kids with serious illnesses. It is our privilege to be able to hold a ride at such a wonderful place. We all need to do our part to ensure not only that each of us are safe but that these kids have a safe environment to go to once COVID 19 is over.
- Should you stop at a water stop on trail, please remain socially distant. Use the water then move away for others to move in. There will be additional water tubs for multiple riders at most stations.

**COVID-19 SAFETY REQUIREMENTS ACKNOWLEDGMENT FORM**

Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) is a respiratory disease caused by the SARS-CoV-2 virus. To reduce the impact of COVID-19 outbreak conditions on riders, ride personnel, volunteers, vendors, sponsors, hosts, and any participant or spectator at the Autumn Gallop at Camp Boggy Creek ride, the following safety requirements are to be followed:

**MASKS OR FACE COVERINGS**

- Types of face coverings can include a paper or disposable mask, a cloth mask, a neck gaiter, a scarf, a bandanna, or a religious face covering and are required at all times.
- A face covering must cover the nose and mouth completely.
- The covering should not be overly tight or restrictive and should feel comfortable to wear.

- Any mask that incorporates a valve that is designed to facilitate easy exhaling, mesh masks, or masks with openings, holes, visible gaps, or vents in the material are not sufficient face coverings because they allow droplets to be released from the mask and should not be worn.

#### **HANDWASHING AND SANITIZING**

- Hands should be washed frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds when visibly soiled, before eating, after using the restroom or coming into close contact with any person.
- Hands should be sanitized frequently with a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.

#### **SANITIZING SURFACES**

- Surfaces should be sanitized frequently; especially when spaces are shared with others or there are common areas being used or touched by multiple people.

#### **SOCIAL DISTANCING**

- A distance of at least 6 feet (about 2 arms' length) from other people who are not from your household in both indoor and outdoor spaces is required.
