What is the Alzheimer's Support Network?

The Alzheimer's Support Network is a *local*, not-for-profit 501(c)3 corporation dedicated to serving the thousands of families dealing with Alzheimer's disease or another form of dementia in Collier County.

One in three families is affected in some way by Alzheimer's disease. The progression of this fatal illness ranges from 2 to 20 years. Presently, there is no known cure. Due to the nature of the caregiving burden, Alzheimer's disease seriously impacts the lives of everyone in the family. Often the only help available is through organizations like ours. In the **32** years that this organization has been in existence, countless families have sought and received our help. Currently, we serve nearly 3,500 families in Southwest Florida.

Services are offered free of charge and include:

☑ a Caregivers' Resource Center containing information on Alzheimer's disease and subjects important to those who care for someone with a dementia;
a comprehensive website (www.AlzSupport.org) featuring articles on all areas of caregiving and dementia, program news and community events
☑ support groups (28 meetings each month) including general discussions as well as specialized groups (for male caregivers, newly diagnosed, adult children, etc.);
☑ special care room for loved ones during support group meetings:
monthly educational meetings open to the public, featuring nationally known and local experts;
☑ a 24-hour Helpline;
individual and family problem solving;
informed referral to area services;
programs for persons diagnosed with a memory disorder
advocacy for people suffering from dementia
☑ a Wanderer's Identification Program and Locator Program in coordination with the Sheriff's Department.

Funding for the Alzheimer's Support Network is entirely through individual and corporate donations. <u>One hundred percent of funds raised stay in the community and are used for direct services.</u>
