

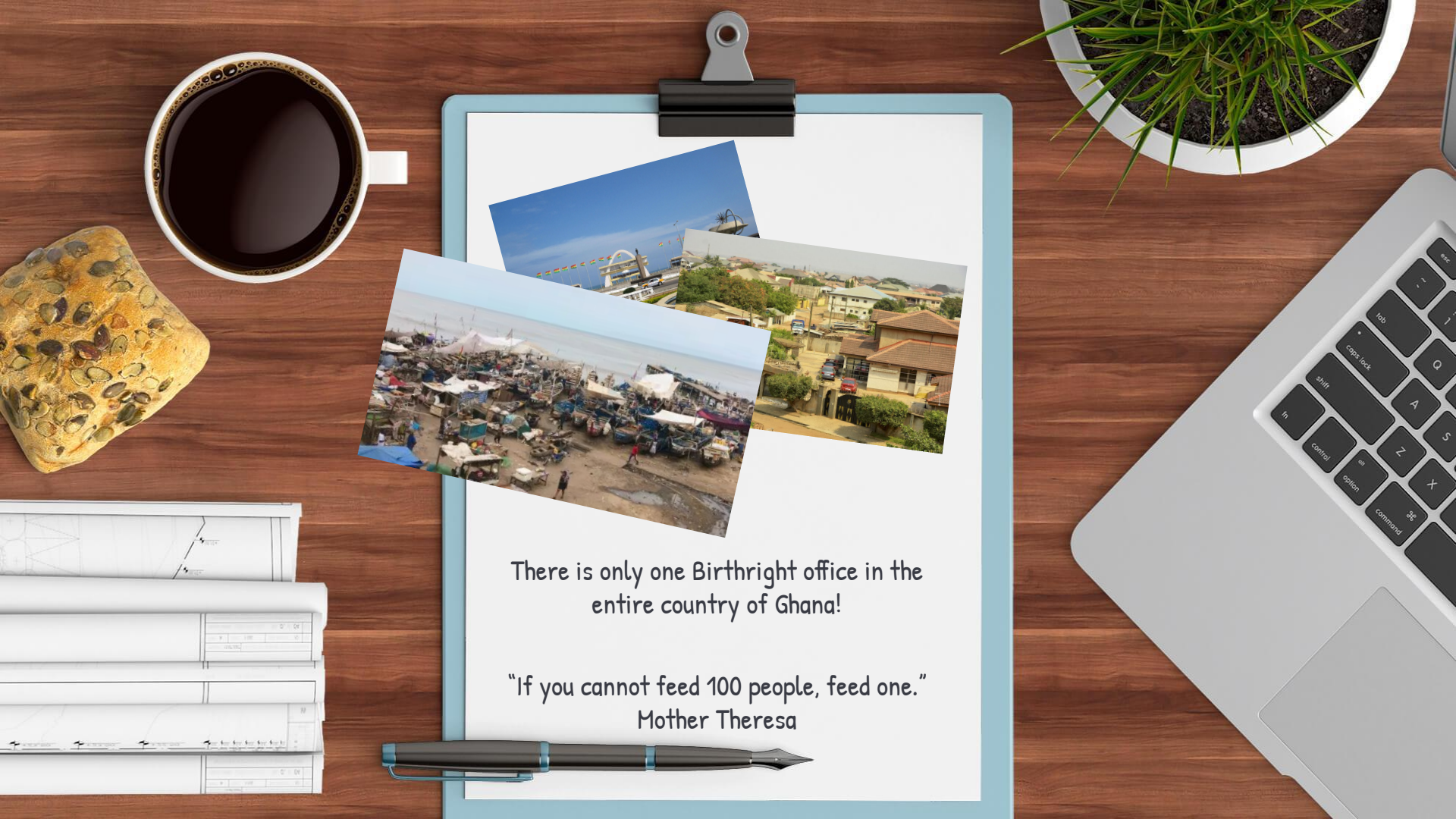


Ghana became an

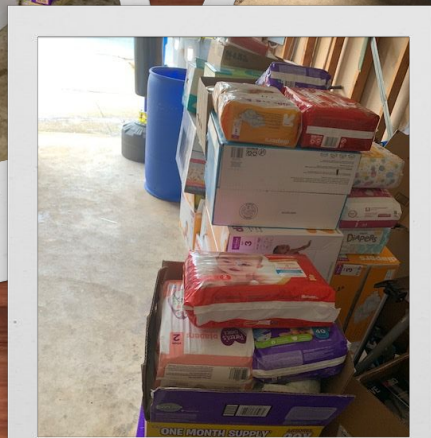
We are open because of you!

HOW DO OUR CLIENTS GET YOUR DONATIONS?

Barrels are shipped to Ghana from ports in Philadelphia, PA. 6 to 8 weeks later the items arrive in Ghana and are cleared from the port.

They are then sent to a storage facility for customer pick up. We hire a car, pick up these barrels and take them to our office.

We sometimes wash, iron and store baby items for our clients. Baby items are sometimes even mailed to clients who are hours away.

prepared to be shipped!




Empty barrels are used to

It's a miracle we are still open and fully operating during this pandemic.

Since January 1 to April 8,
2021 we have served 259
nursing mothers, handled 511
appointments and phone calls
and know of 34 babies born.

Thousands of babies have been
saved!

Mothers have had healthier
pregnancies and babies!

We are a safe place for women/
girls when they need help.

Hopeless to Hopeful Program Since 2017

- ❑ Provide skills for women / girls with a goal to become self-supporting.
- ❑ Provide equipment such as sewing machines or beautician supplies.
- ❑ Some of our mothers are financially challenged with no hope. For lack of a few hundred dollars, they are stuck in a life of poverty.
- ❑ With careful guidance and a small amount of funds, mothers have a future.
- ❑ In the past 4 years, 50 mothers have been given hope for a different future!



Our plans for the future

- ❑ A 24 hour hotline in Ghana.
- ❑ More speaking engagements and signboards to Create more awareness of the help Birthright provides to mothers in difficult pregnancy situations.
- ❑ Sell more made-in-Ghana products to raise awareness and funds.



For our 17th anniversary, our goal is to get a billboard on the major highway!










Right now, we have 6 signboards that are (long) walking distances from the office.

- ❑ Most importantly, keep us in your prayers.






