



Deer - Resistant Perennials

Think hairy and smelly! Plants like lavender and rosemary, bee-balm and lamb's ears, mints and members of the onion family are rarely bothered. Given that, if the herd is large or there are many youngsters, damage can occur simply from their tendency to sample. Enough nibbles - even if spat out - and your plants can be significantly injured. The following typically survive the onslaught...
