<u>Resolution 2021-09 Annual Review of PayScale/Stipend Acknowledgment:</u>

Motion: Commissioner Graham motioned to approve the Resolution for the Annual PayScale/Stipend Review. The motion **was seconded** by Commissioner Bjornstad and approved.

Resolution 2021-10 the 2022 BLS Transport Rates:

Motion: Commissioner Moe motioned to approve the Resolution for the BLS Transport Rates for 2022. The motion **was seconded** by Commissioner Graham and approved.

Hiring Position:

The motion **was seconded** by Commissioner Bjornstad and approved. Commissioner Moe abstained from voting due to his relationship with Training Officer Moe

District Chief DeBruin:

Sumas Flood Damage:

- District Chief DeBruin spoke about the Sumas weather related flood situation at the station in Sumas.
- Discussion on FEMA, the navigation and logistics involved in dealing with FEMA.
- Discussion continued on the station in Sumas as far as cost for repairs at the station.
- District Chief DeBruin noted that Ross Widener of Widener & Associates indicated he could represent us for securing funding for the Sumas Station flood situation.
- District Chief DeBruin indicated he is representing the City of Sumas as well.
- District Chief DeBruin indicated the cost would be about \$5,000 for the district.
- Motion: Commissioner Moe motioned to approve the hiring of Ross Widener as a consultant on securing funds for repairs on the Sumas Station due to weather related flooding at the cost of up to \$5,000. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bjornstad and approved.

- District Chief DeBruin spoke about looking into insurance quotes for trying to get a lower cost on the district's insurance coverage.
- Discussion continued on insurance, including flood insurance.

Training Officer Moe:

- Training officer Moe spoke to the latest training going on in our district.

- Training officer Moe noted the upcoming graduation for Fire Academy.
- Training officer Moe indicated he has been busy working on policies for the district
