- Commissioner Graham led the discussion on the Levy Lid
- Commissioner Graham spoke about an Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Bond to support the Advanced Life Support (ALS) system and noted that this may be happening in the fall of 2016
- Discussion continued on the effect this might have on the districts asking to raise the Levy Lid amount
- Commissioner Graham spoke to his proposal hand-out on the Levy Lid and asked District Chief DeBruin and Training Division Lieutenant Moe to help fill in the dates needed to complete his proposal
- Commissioner Graham spoke about doing mailings to the public
- District Chief DeBruin spoke to an email he received from Wain Harrison the Building Services Manager with the County, about the possibility of expansion here at the Kendall Station
- Discussion continued on the possibility of expansion
- District Chief DeBruin indicated he will be meeting with Wain Harrison on the 25th and he will update everyone at the next regular meeting
- District Chief DeBruin spoke about the Levy lid and how this effects the City of Sumas and suggested maybe we do their increases in increments

 - Battalion Chief Christensen indicated all is going well at Welcome

Training Division Lieutenant David Moe:

EMT Class

- Training Division Lieutenant Moe indicated the EMT class is great, we had one student drop out
- Training Division Lieutenant Moe indicated Battalion Chief Christensen has been helping out with the class
- Discussion continued on how much more in-depth this course is now, so much more to memorize and how much harder the testing is and whether the toughness of class really produces a better EMT or not

Emergency Vehicle Incident Prevention (EVIP) Class:

• Training Division Lieutenant Moe indicated that the fist EVIP Class went well and another one will be scheduled soon

Ongoing Training and Evaluation Program (OTEP) Training:

- Training Division Lieutenant Moe spoke to how OTEP Training has gone from group training to more individual online training
- Discussion continued on how to balance it with group as well as individual training

District Chief Jerry DeBruin:

Hose and Fittings:

- District Chief DeBruin spoke again to the hose and fittings that are still available
- District Chief DeBruin indicated he will check into this again about possibly purchasing them

T92 Accident:

- Commissioner Graham asked about the insurance and if any decision was made on the vehicle yet
- District Chief DeBruin indicated it looks like they are leaning towards totaling the vehicle but no decision as of yet had been made

Army Truck:

• District Chief DeBruin indicated that this vehicle might be ready in May to put in service

Dry Summer:

- District Chief DeBruin expressed concerns about the upcoming summer if it proves to be a dry one and what impact that will have on them as a district
- Commissioner Bjornstad is concerned with all the logging debris left after a logging operation has taken place

Firewise Program:

- District Chief DeBruin spoke about the Firewise Program (a local program for fire safety by involving the community to take part in taking individual responsibility for preparing their homes from the risk of wildfire)
- Discussion continued on the pros and cons of this program

Extra Vacuum Mattresses:

• District Chief DeBruin mentioned we now have four more vacuum mattresses so one should always be available for use

New Business:

• Commissioner Graham indicated he was at a meeting where Dr. David Lynch from the Chuckanut Health Foundation spoke to how he wants to do more public education for awareness of early signs of stroke

CPR Classes:

• Commissioner Bjornstad heard from the community that the public offered CPR Classes went well

• District Chief DeBruin mentioned the passing of Randolph Scott a former district volunteer and was a key figure in Emergency Medical Services (EMS) system for Whatcom County
