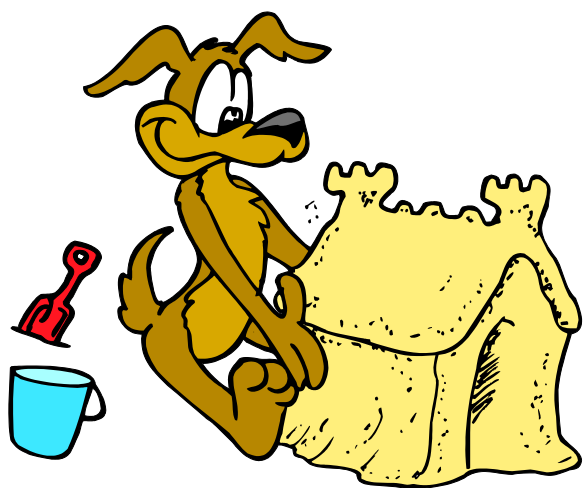


# Glorybound Kids books

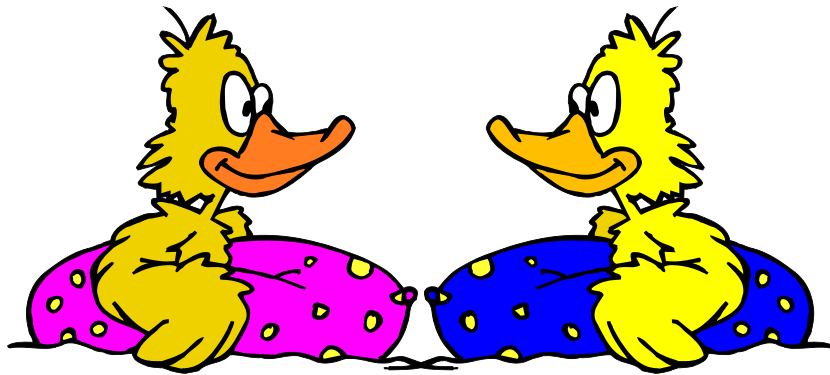

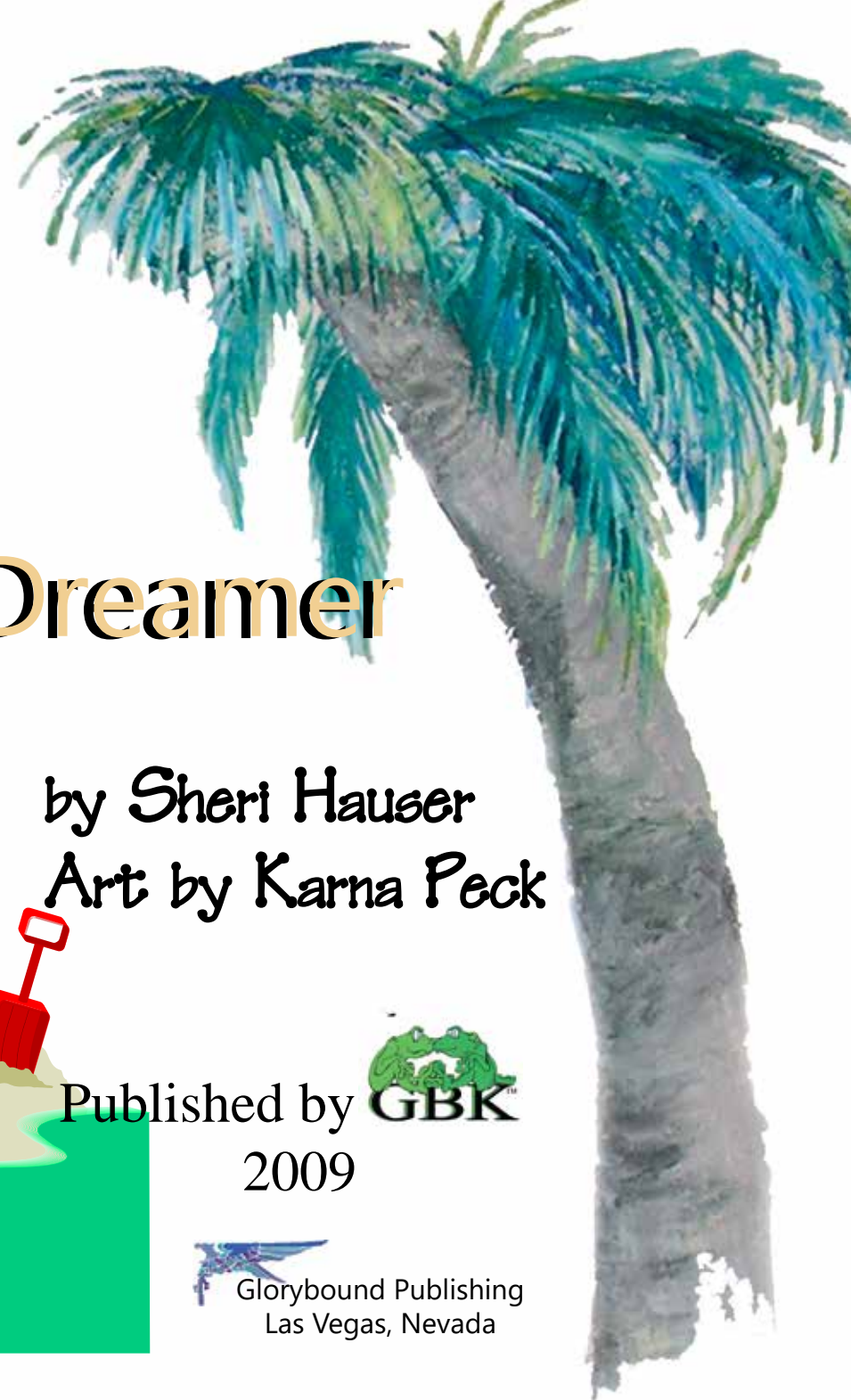

So, she ran for her mother to tell her





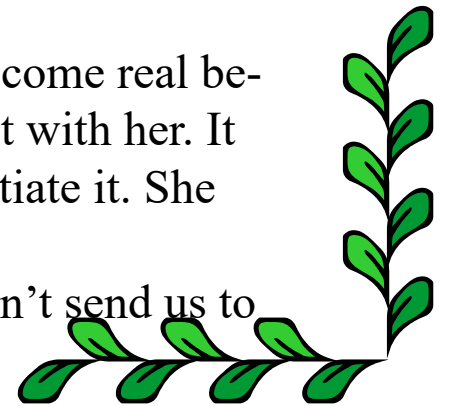

The dream did not become real because her friend believed it with her. It only helped her to substantiate it. She knew it was true all along.

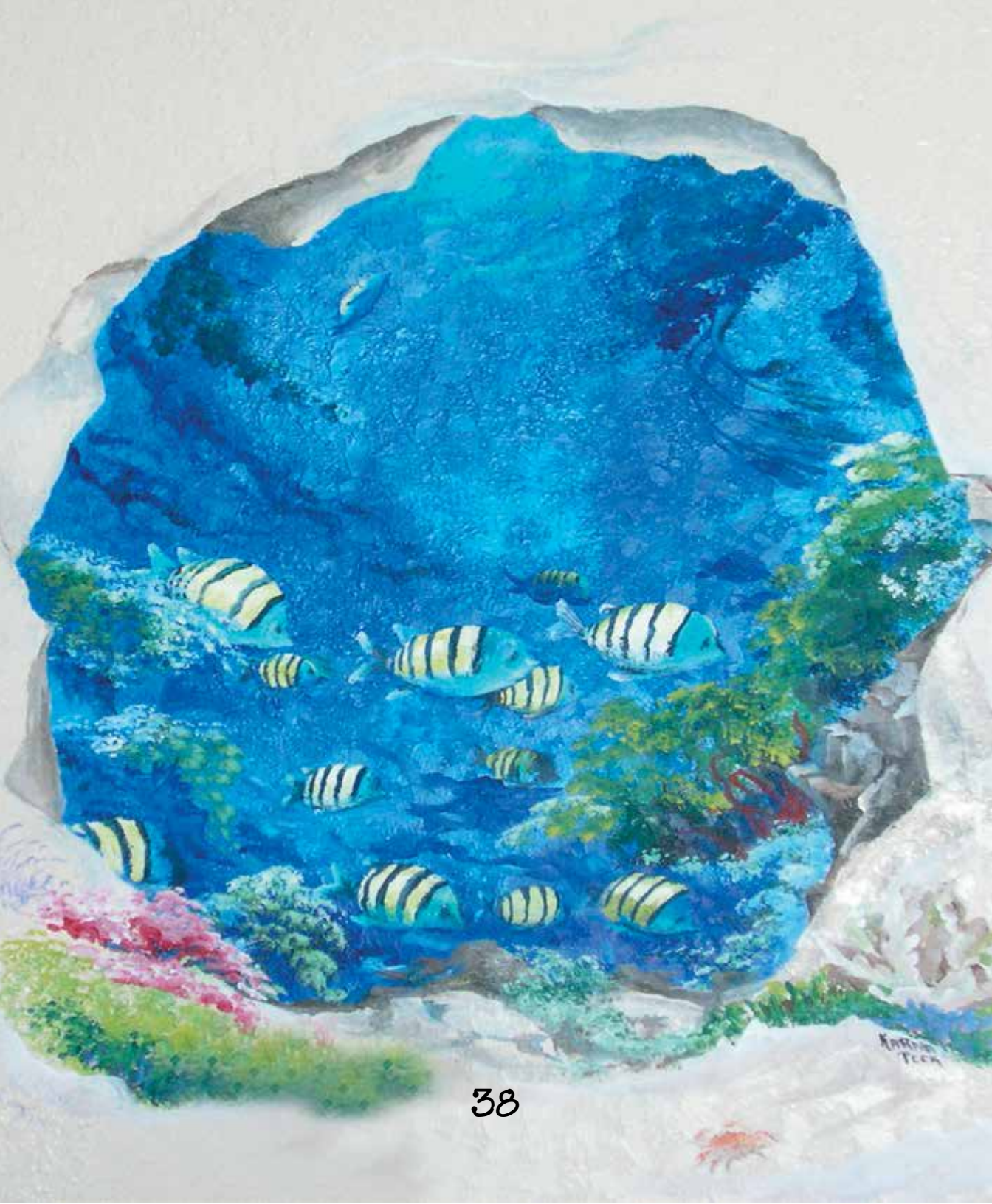
