
Ince upon a time Soaker the frog and two ducks, Artie and Spiff, lived in a pond. They were good friends.










It was a hot summer and the water felt great to play in.









Soaker was a happy frog









Artie and Spiff were happy, too.





But, then he saw something which made him sad.






As Summer days passed Soaker noticed that the water was getting lower and lower in the pond.

"We love you," Said Artie "Yes," Said Spiff.


"Soaker, we won't want you to shrink because we would miss you dearly."





They thought of a plan to save him. After talking it over between themselves, they approached Soaker carrying a stick.






Artie said, "We know of a pond that is not drying up a short ways away. If you can hold onto this stick with your mouth we will fly you to the new place."

Artie and Spiff carefully selected just the right stick for the flight and instructed Soaker on how to hold on properly so that they could all fly as a team.






"Hold on tight!" Spiff let out a quack.

It was an amazing lift-off just in time as the final water left the pond. They flew with Soaker holding firm by his little frog mouth to the stick.






Soaker was heavy for his friends because they held his entire weight by their beaks, but they loved him and wanted to help him, so they held tight keeping their beaks shut.

With the new pond in sight, they all flew in unison over the fields and grasslands. They flew over Farmer Loyd's Ranch because it was in between the two ponds.






Just as they topped the string beans, Farmer Loyd looked up into the sky.

"This is the most amazing thing I have ever seen. Surely those two ducks love their friend."






Soaker could not resist taking credit for the idea, so as his warty feet skipped over the bean field, he cried out to Farmer Loyd, "I did!"

"I just caught me a fantastic flying talking frog." He declared with joy.






Artie and Spiff dropped the stick and let out a quack in unison. They told him to keep his mouth shut. It was for his own good. Now, he would become a house pet.

They each dipped a wing in a wave to Soaker and flew to the new pond without him.






he moral of the story is:
