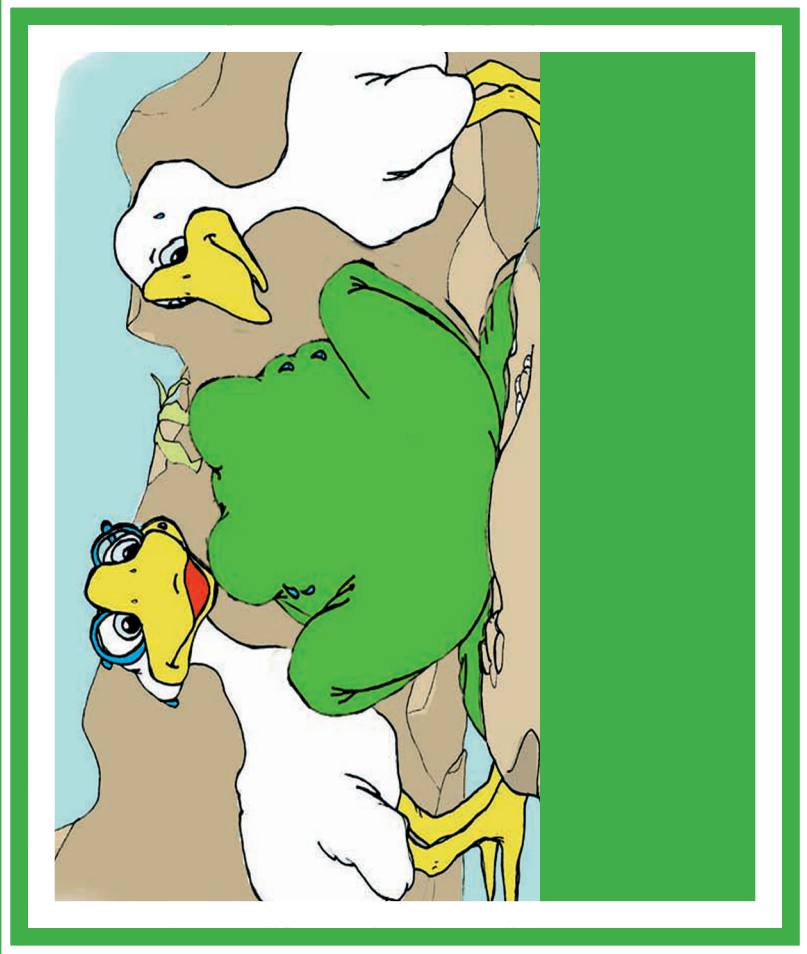


# Fantastic Flying Frog

## Glorybound Kids books

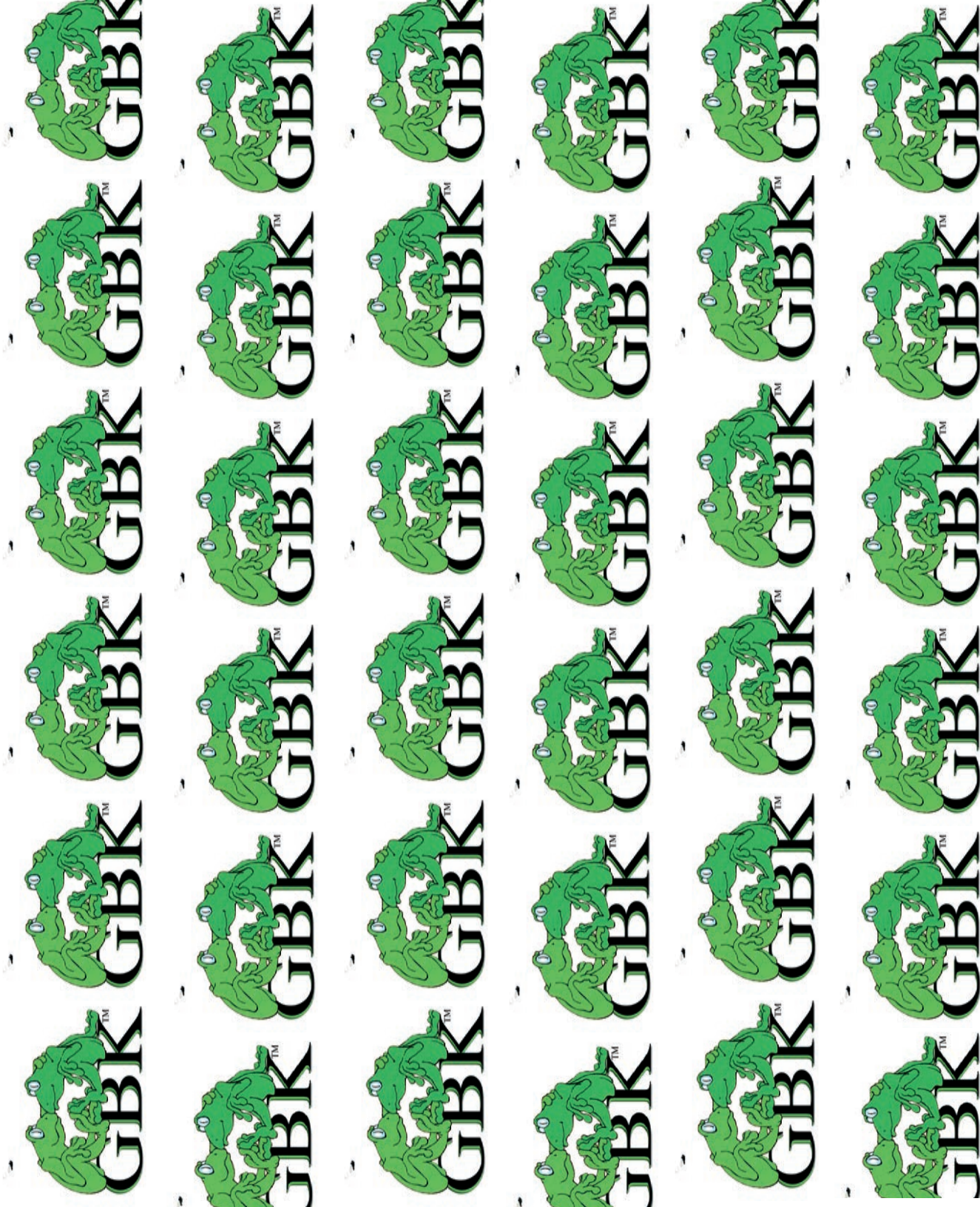

They were good friends.

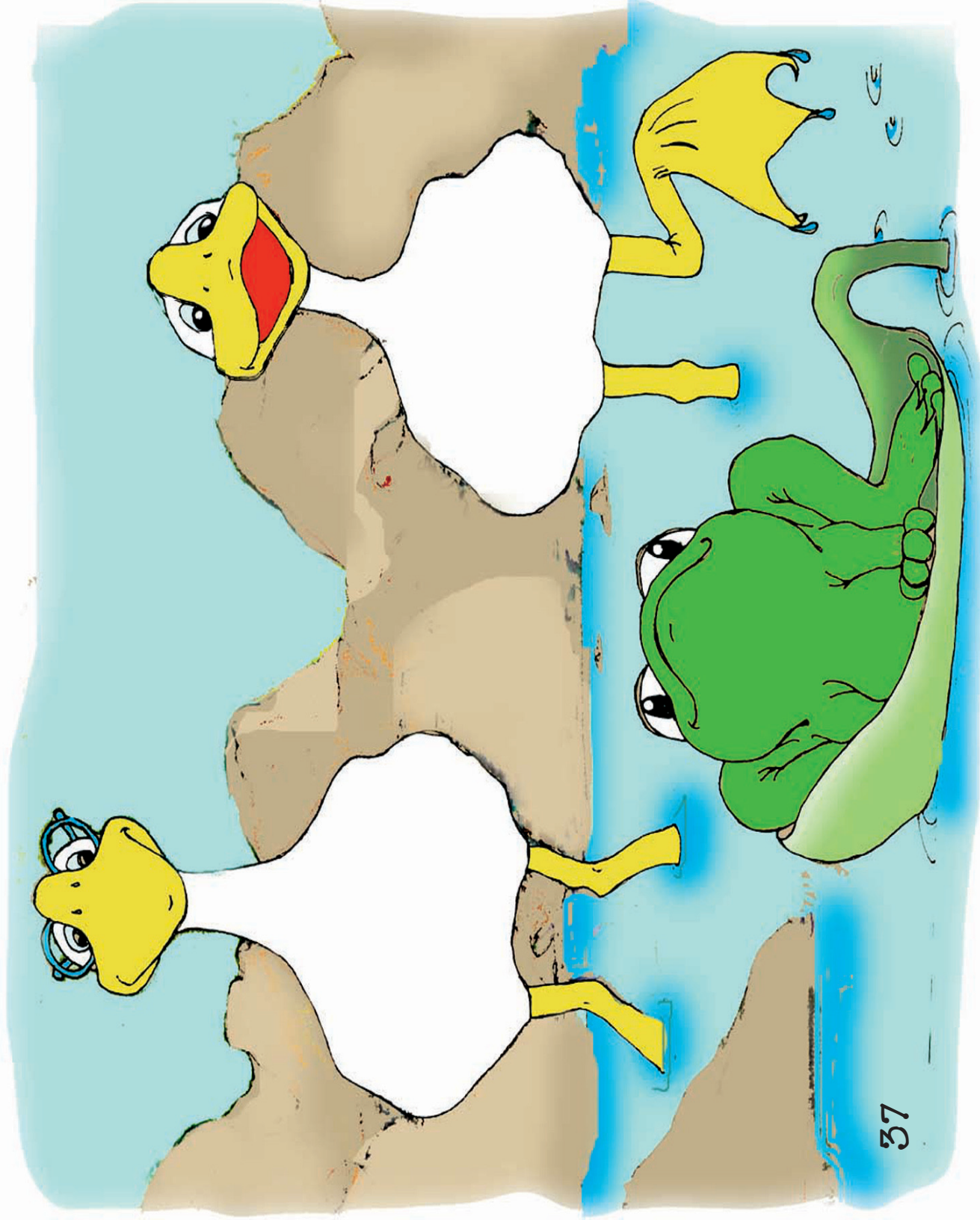








It was a hot summer and the

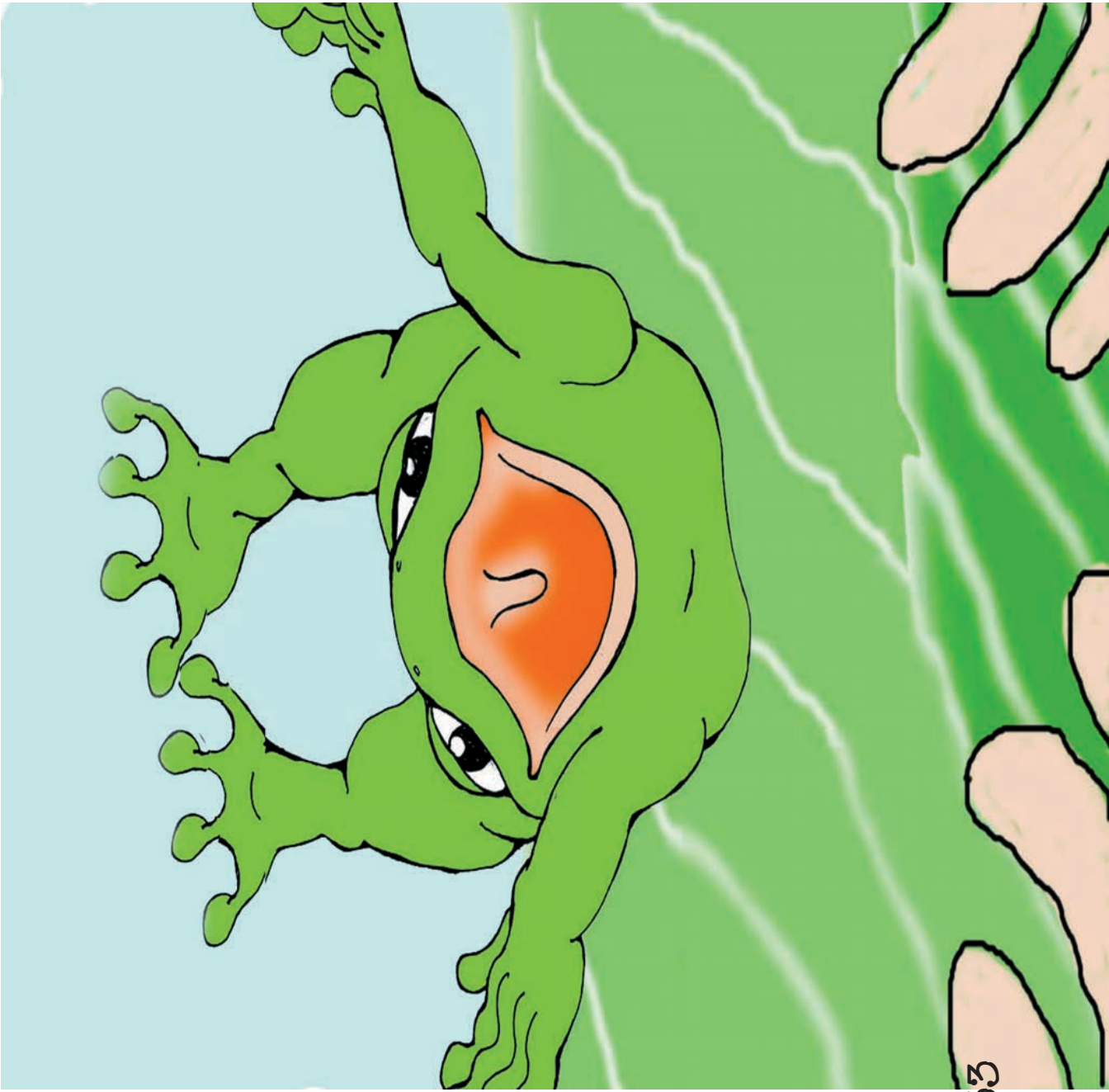
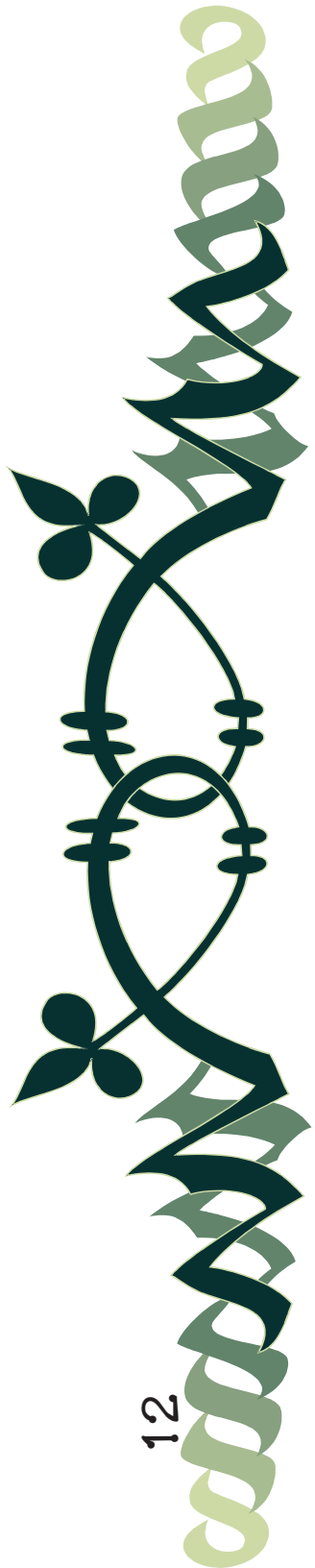
Artie and Spiff dropped the stick and let out a quack in unison. They told him to keep his mouth shut. It was for his own good. Now, he would become a house pet.

Soaker could not resist taking credit for the idea, so as his warty feet skipped over the bean field, he cried out to Farmer Loyd, “I did!”

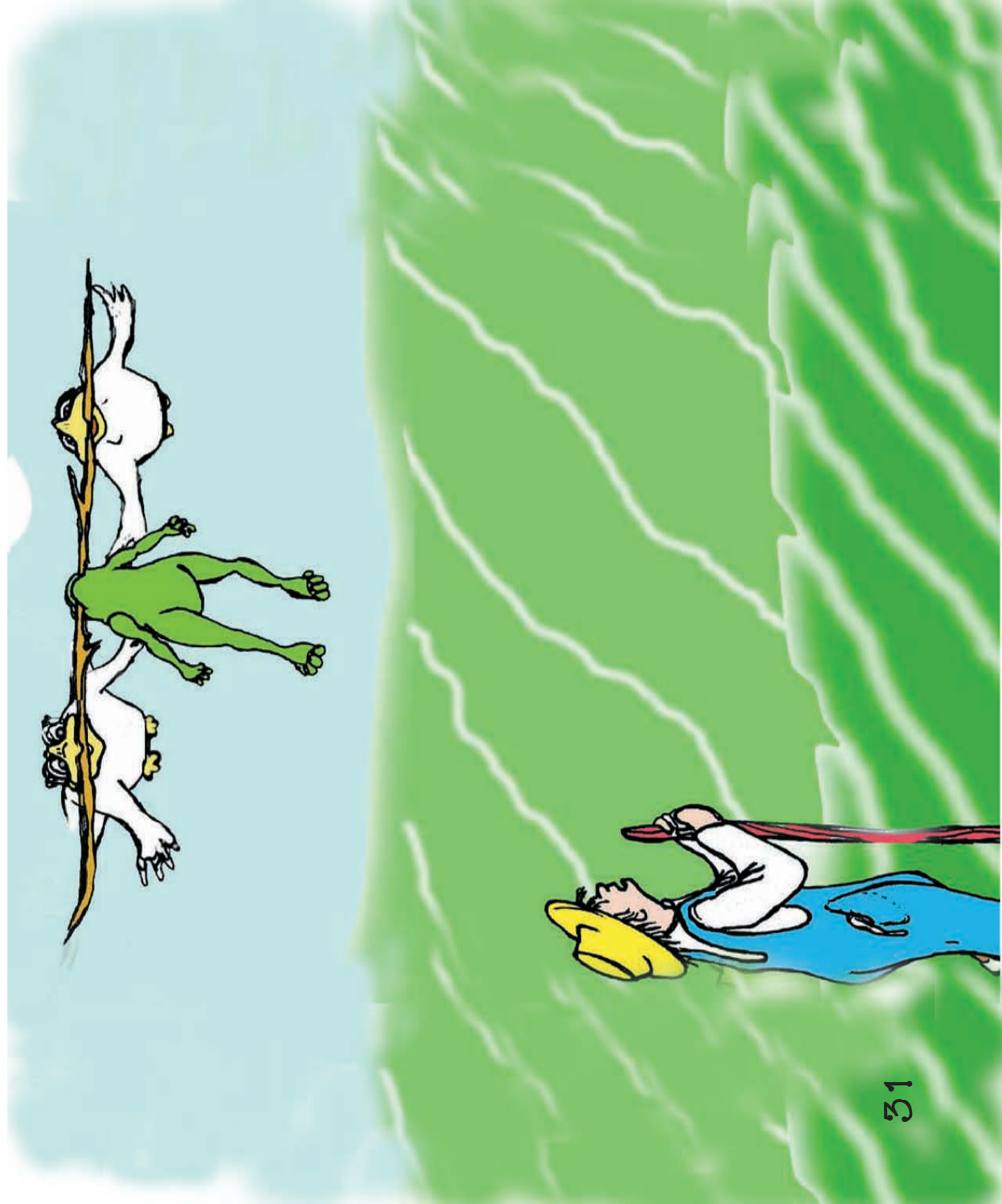
“It was my idea.”

made him sad.

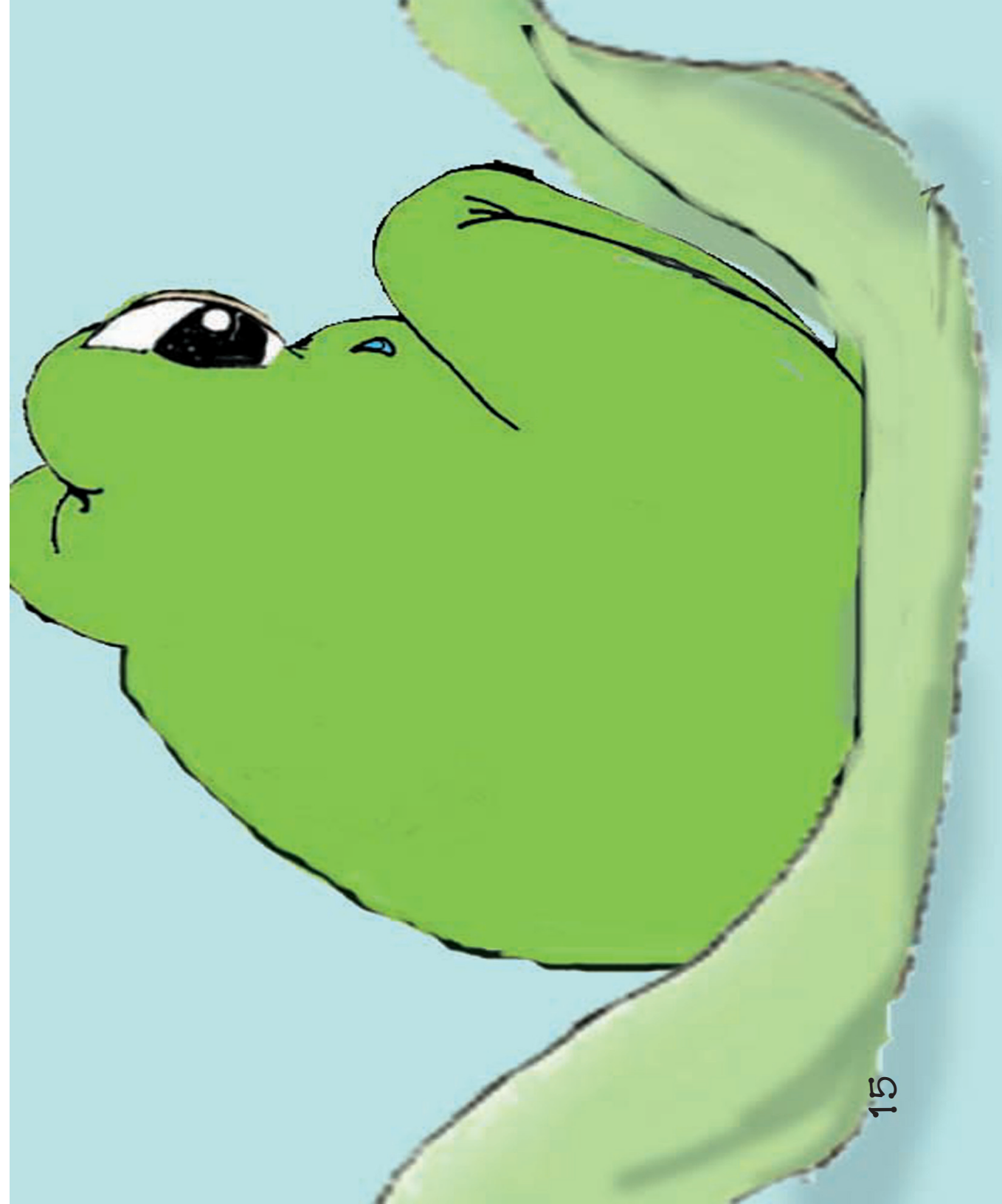


Just as they topped the string beans, Farmer Loyd looked up into the sky.

“I wonder who thought of that ingenious idea of this fantastic fly-ing frog?”

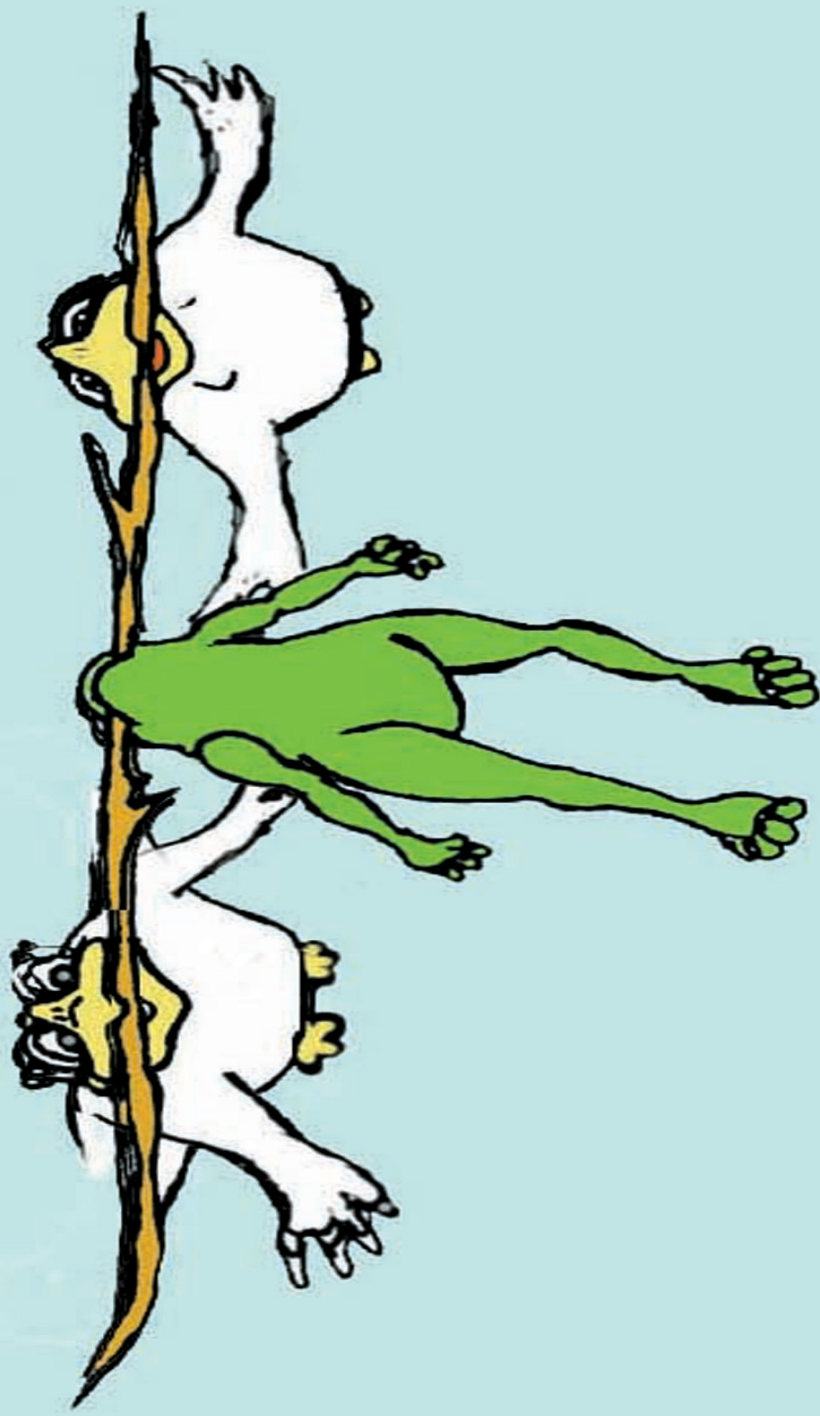
“This is the most amazing thing I have ever seen. Surely those two ducks love their friend.”





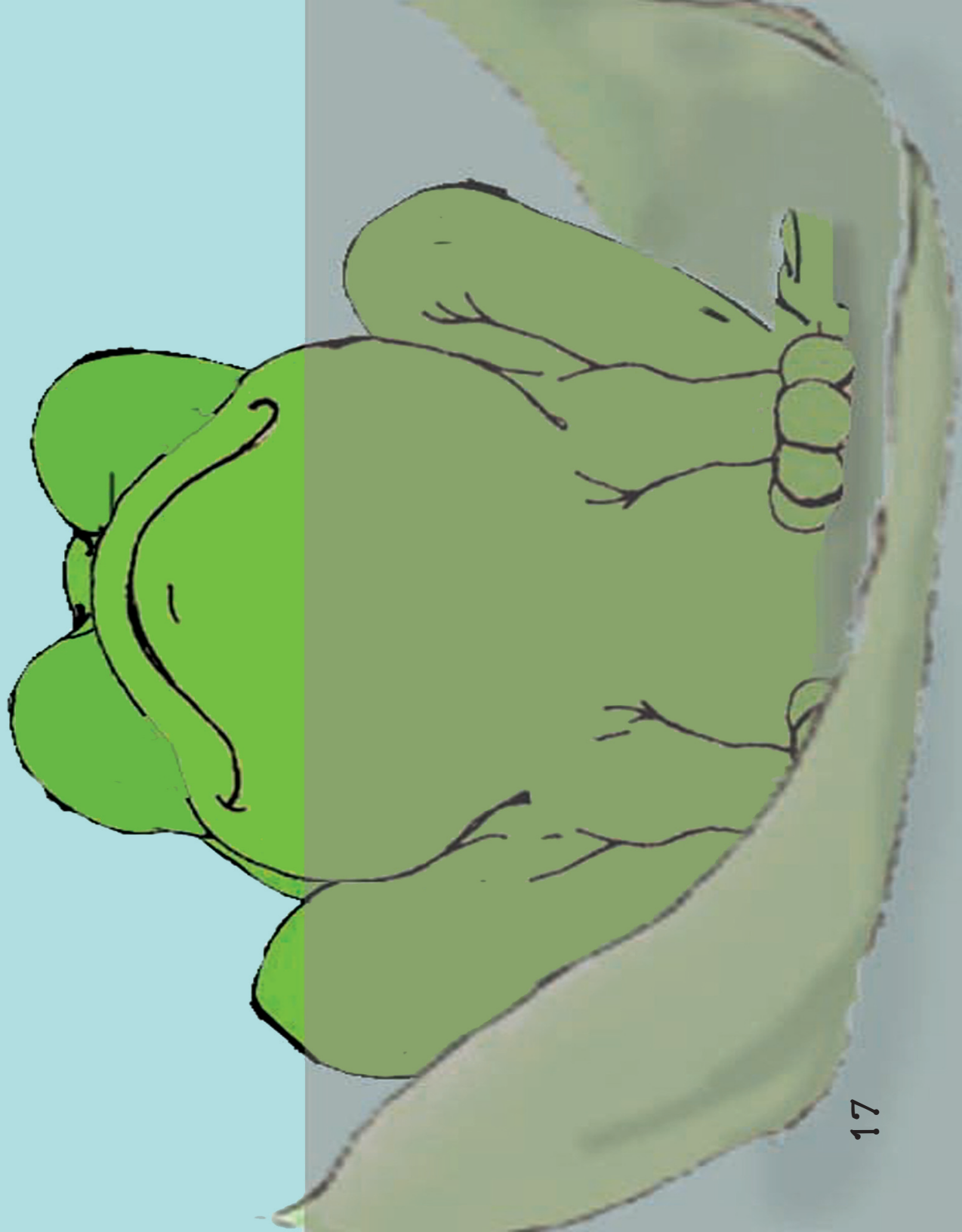
As Summer days passed Soaker noticed that the water was getting lower and lower in the pond.

He told Artie and Spiff, “I am afraid the water is going to disappear and then I will shrink to nothing.”



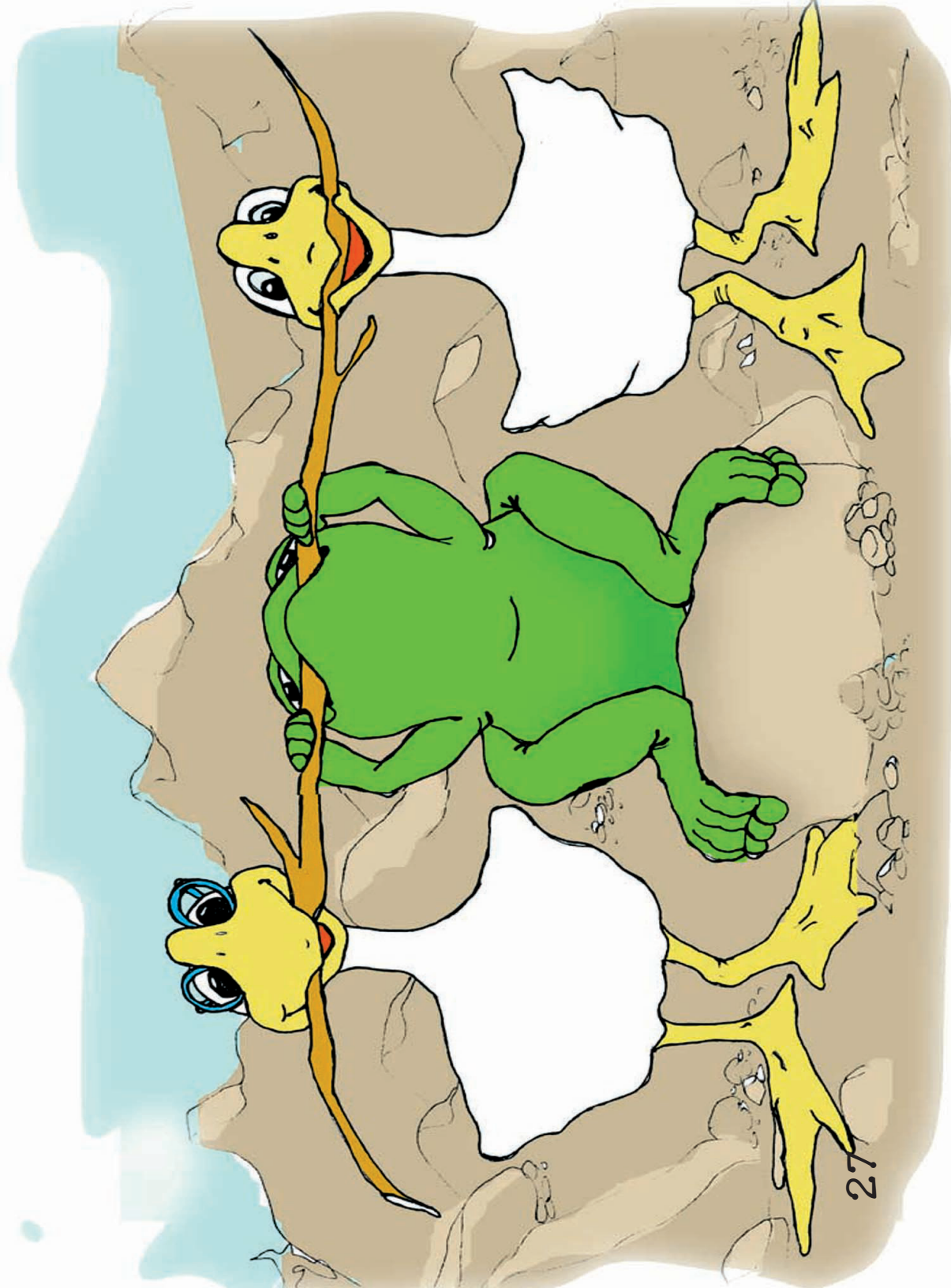
Soaker was heavy for his friends because they held his entire weight by their beaks, but they loved him and wanted to help him, so they held tight keeping their beaks shut.

With the new pond in sight, they all flew in unison over the fields and grasslands. They flew over Farmer Loyd's Ranch because it was in between the two ponds.





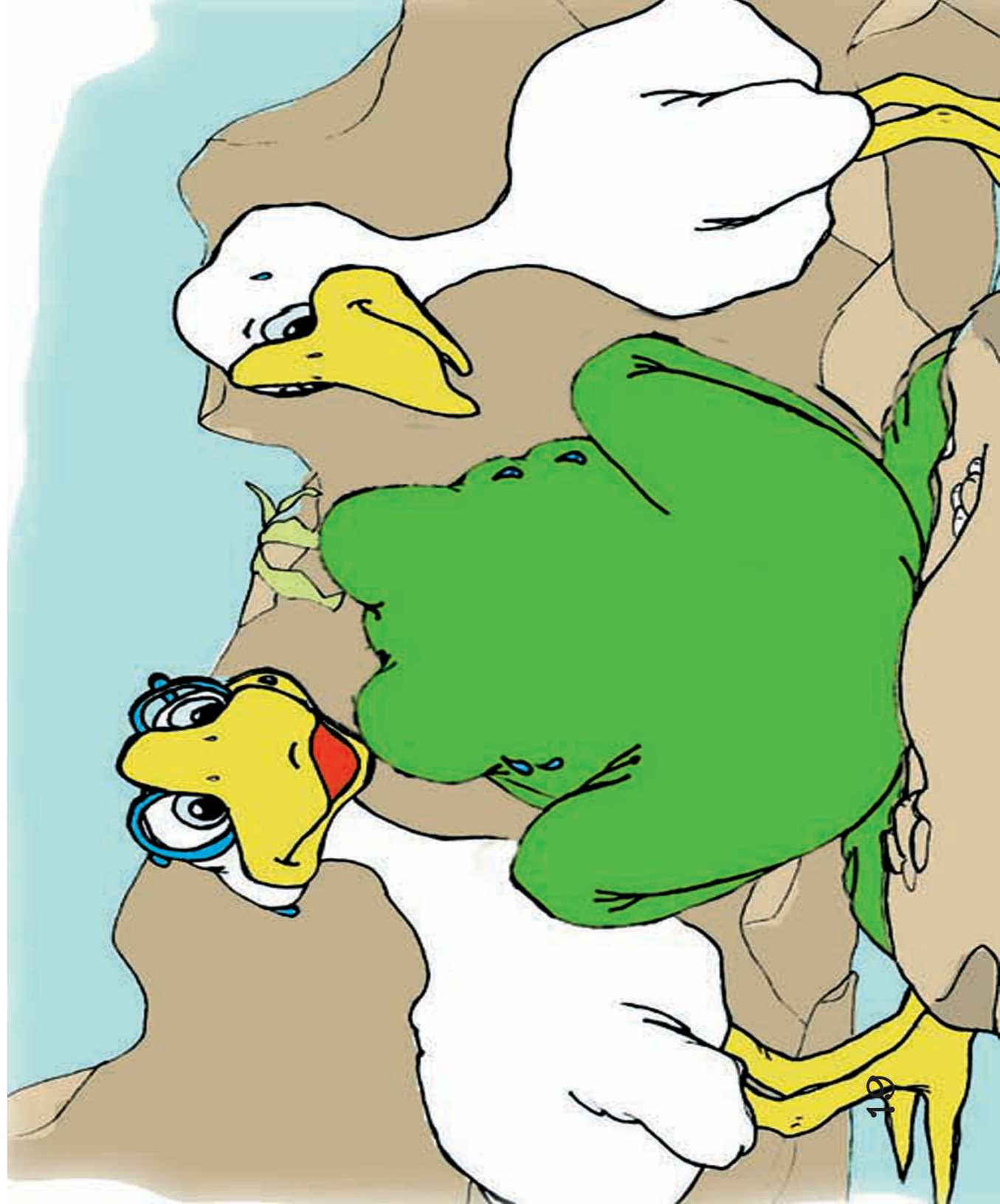
“We love you,” Said Artie

“Hold on tight!” Spiff let out a quack.

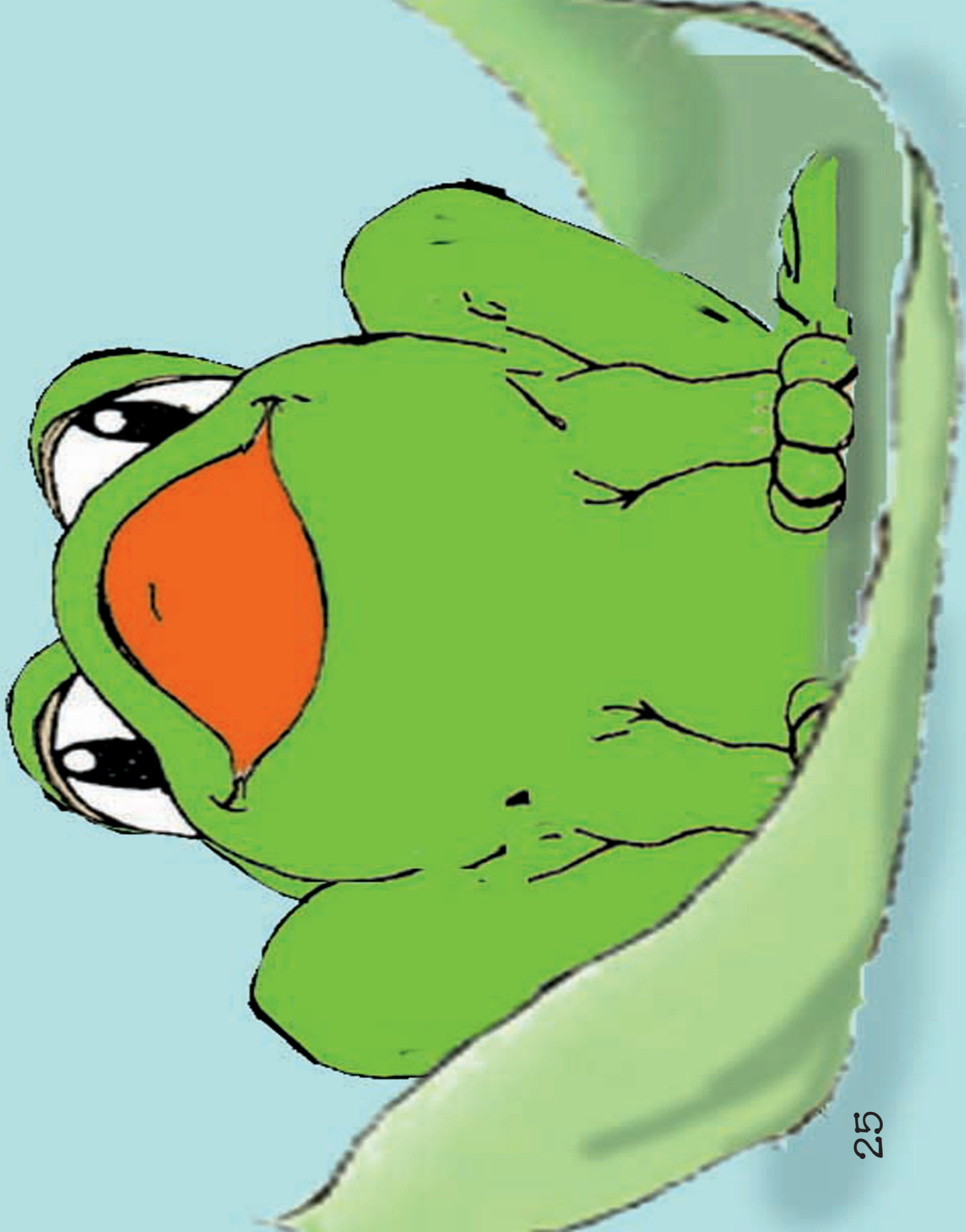
On Artie’s count, “1, 2, 3,” the two ducks took a running leap spreading their giant white wings into the air.
