Glorybound Kids books sneak celery into the diet by putting peanut butter on it. What we offer is sweet moral fiber combined with educational learning.

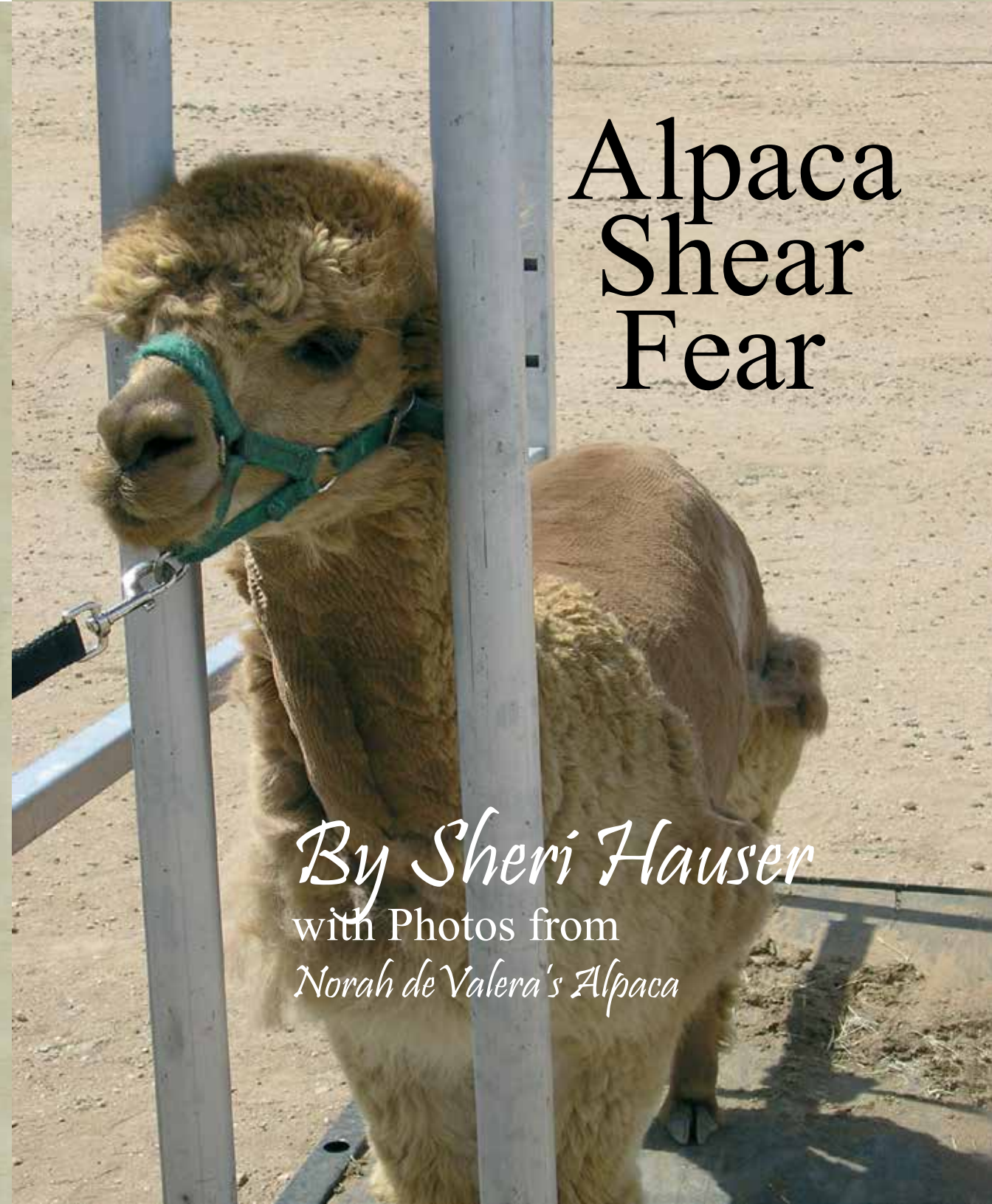

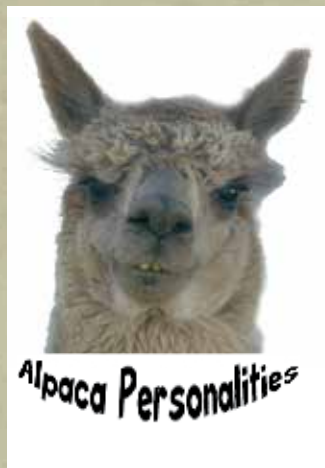

Just as Stella Ardella planned.





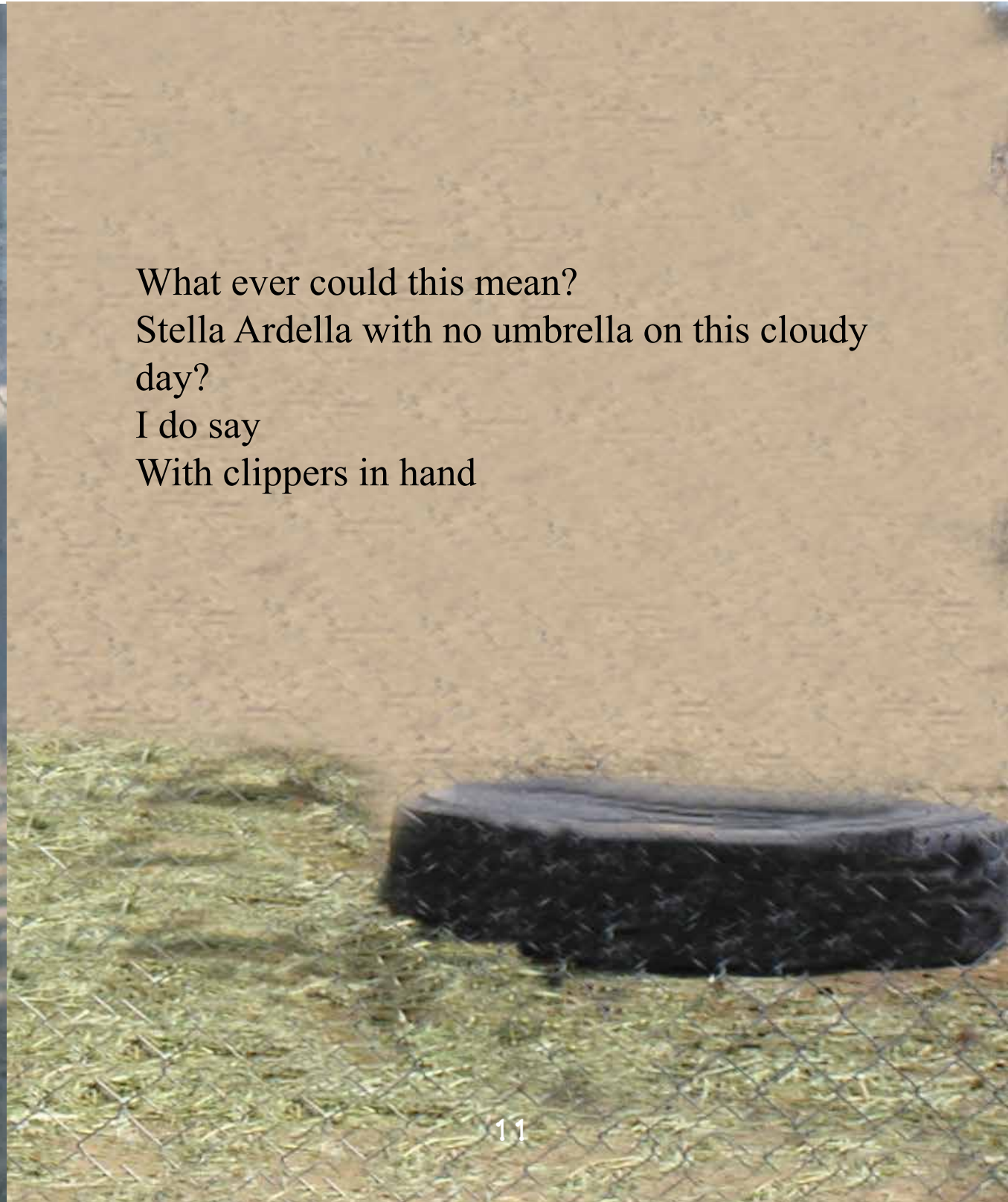


And, afterwards, she had fun smiling the rest
Because they were next in line for shearing time.

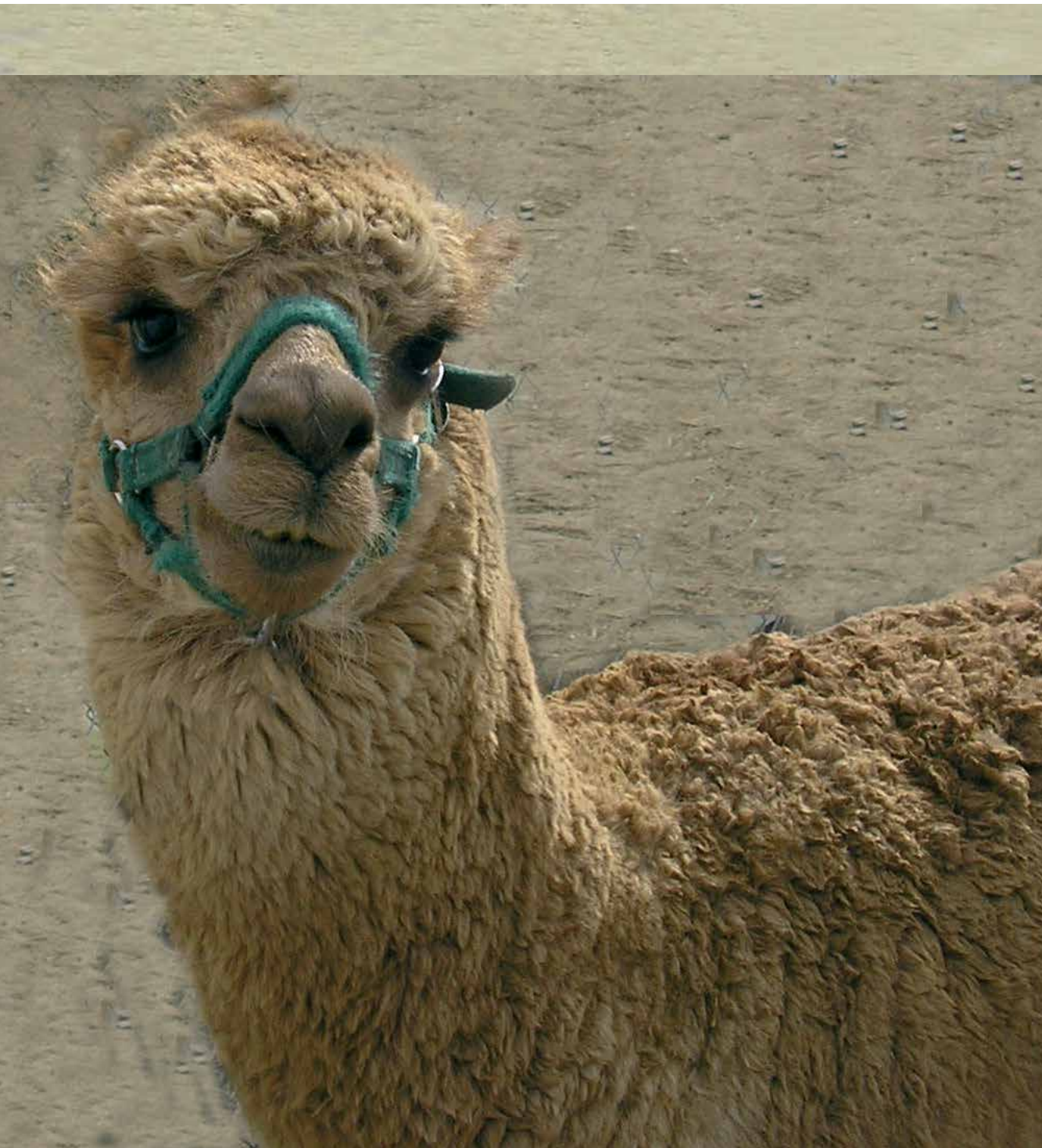

Then you can kick up your heels and go into the field to play.”

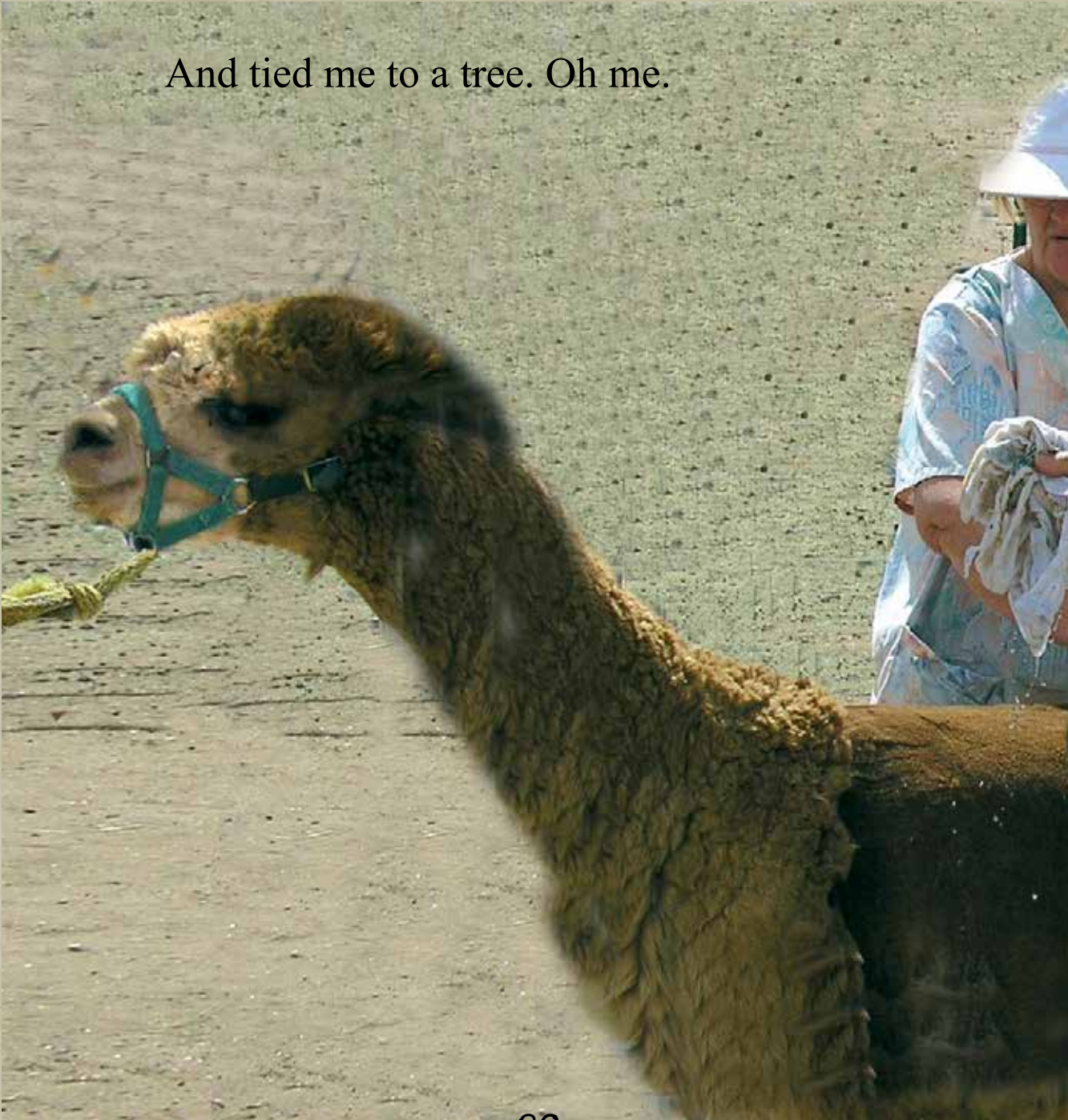


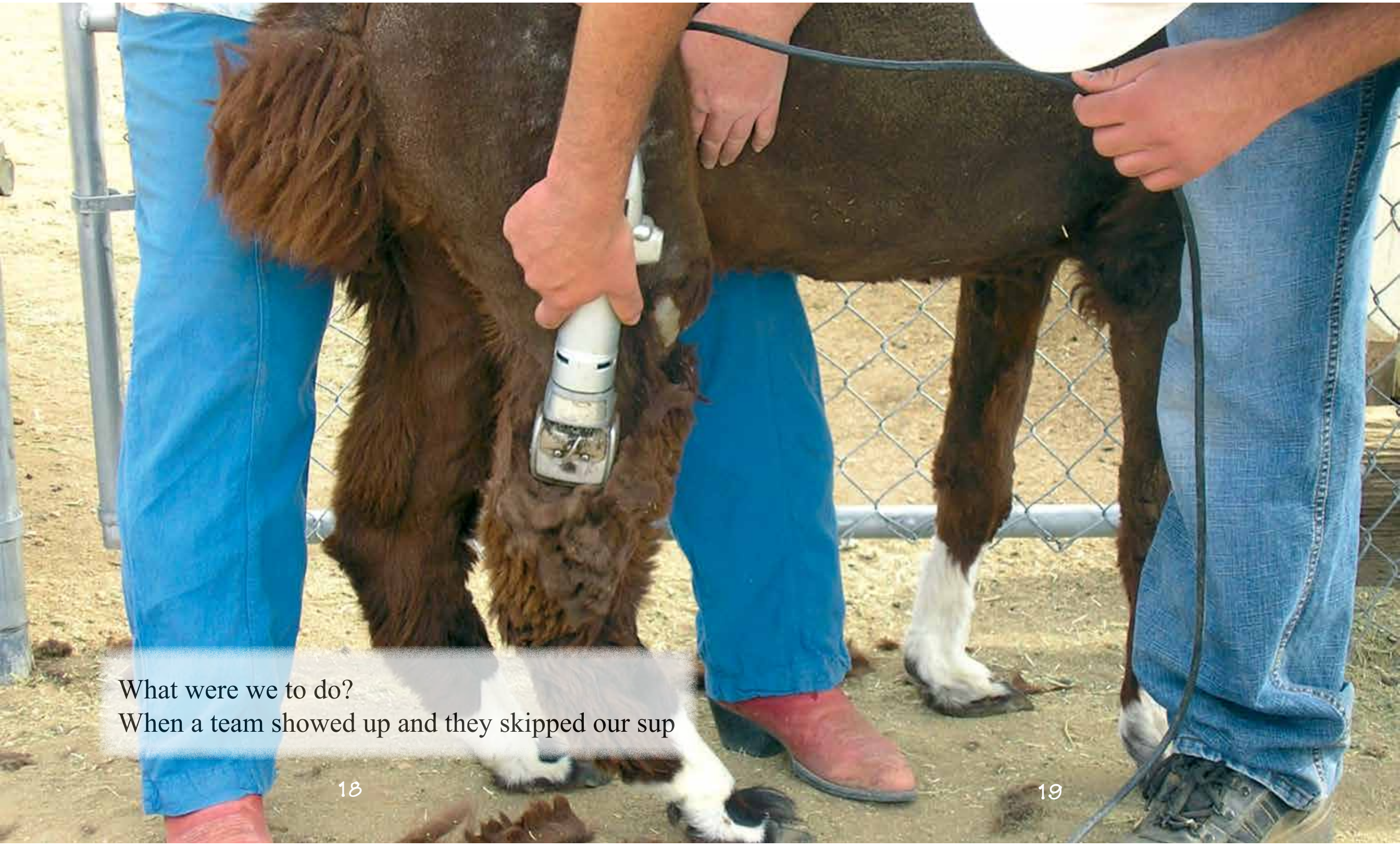


As papa looked on and momma, too
