

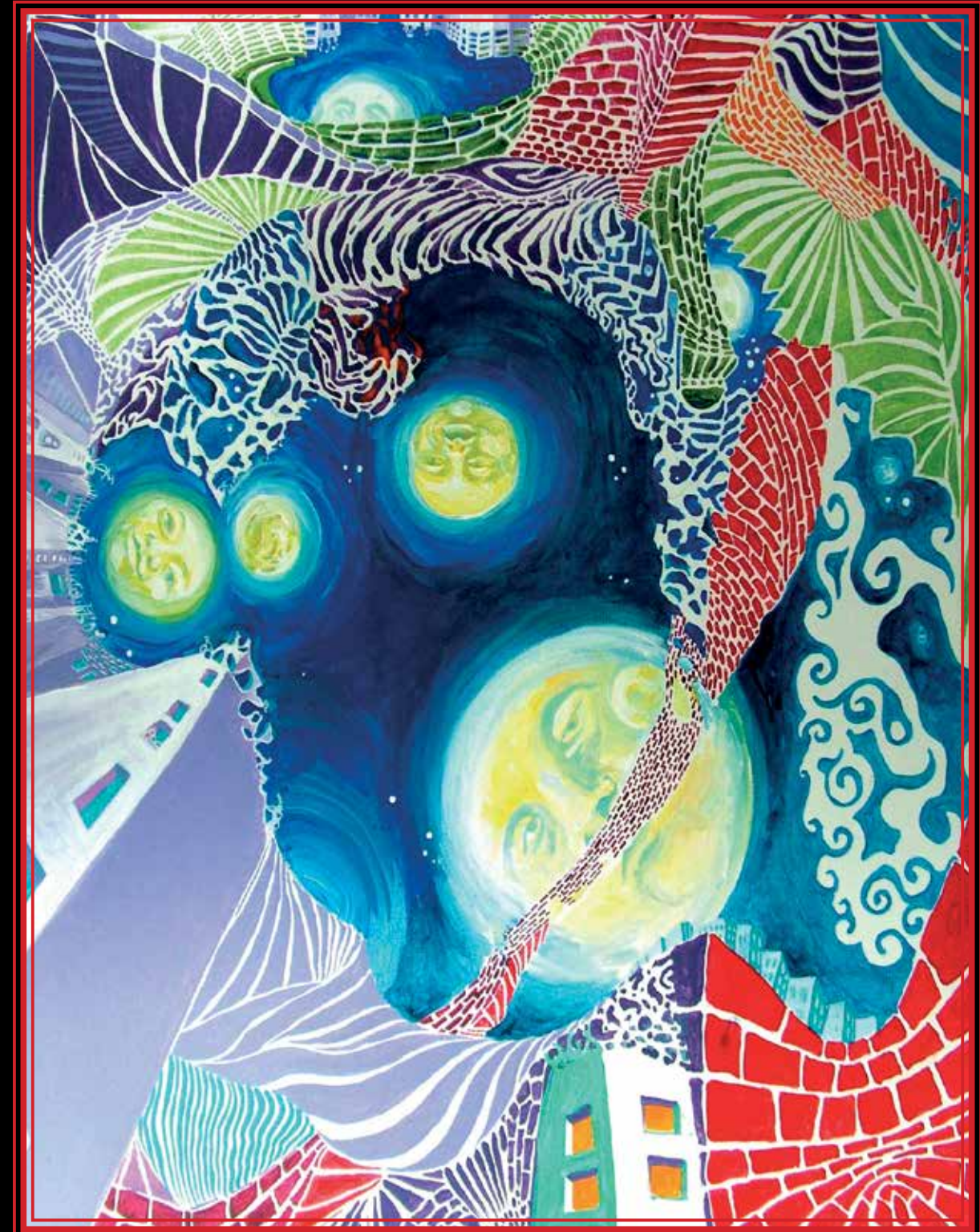
Prophetic Art

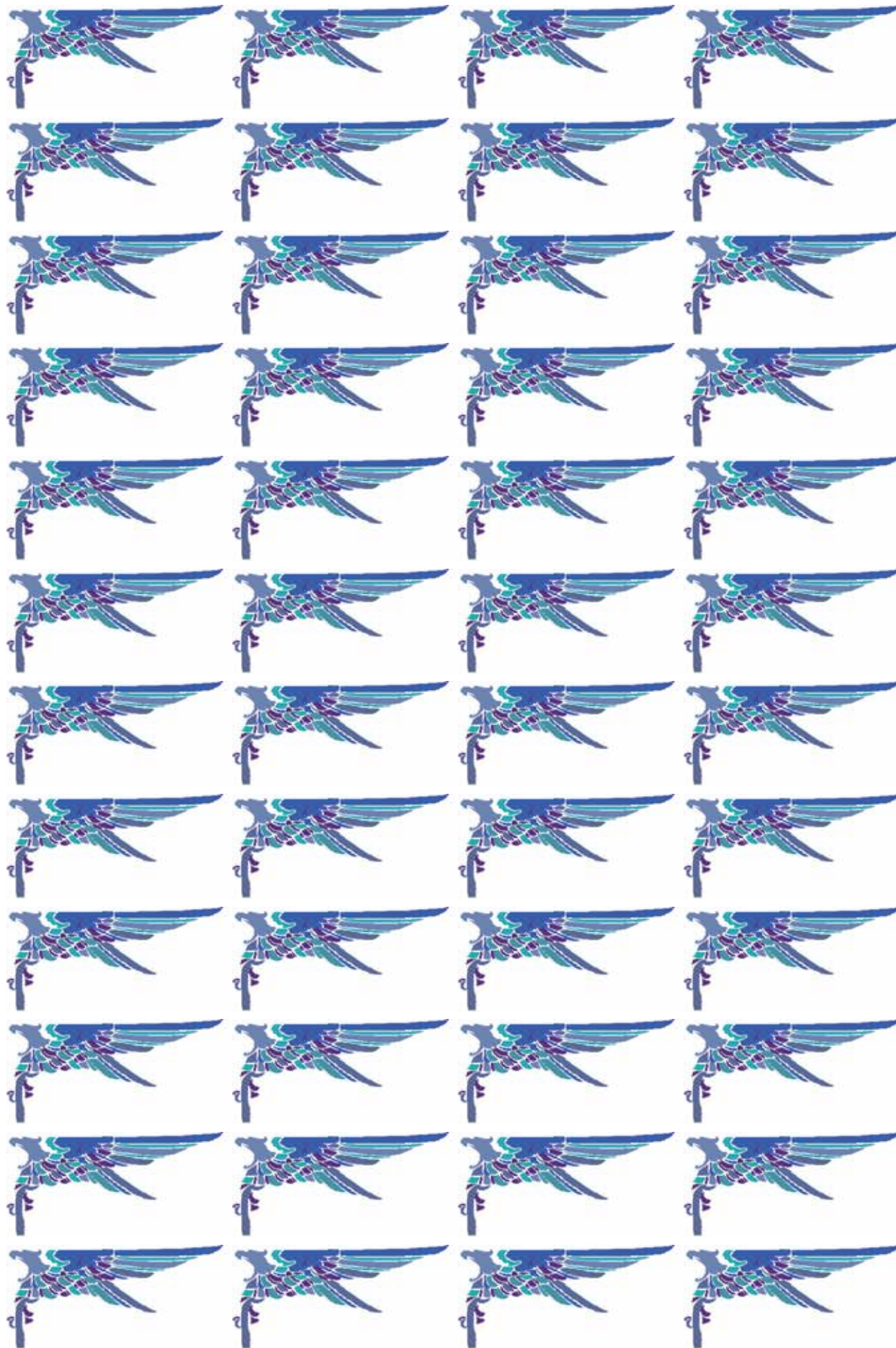

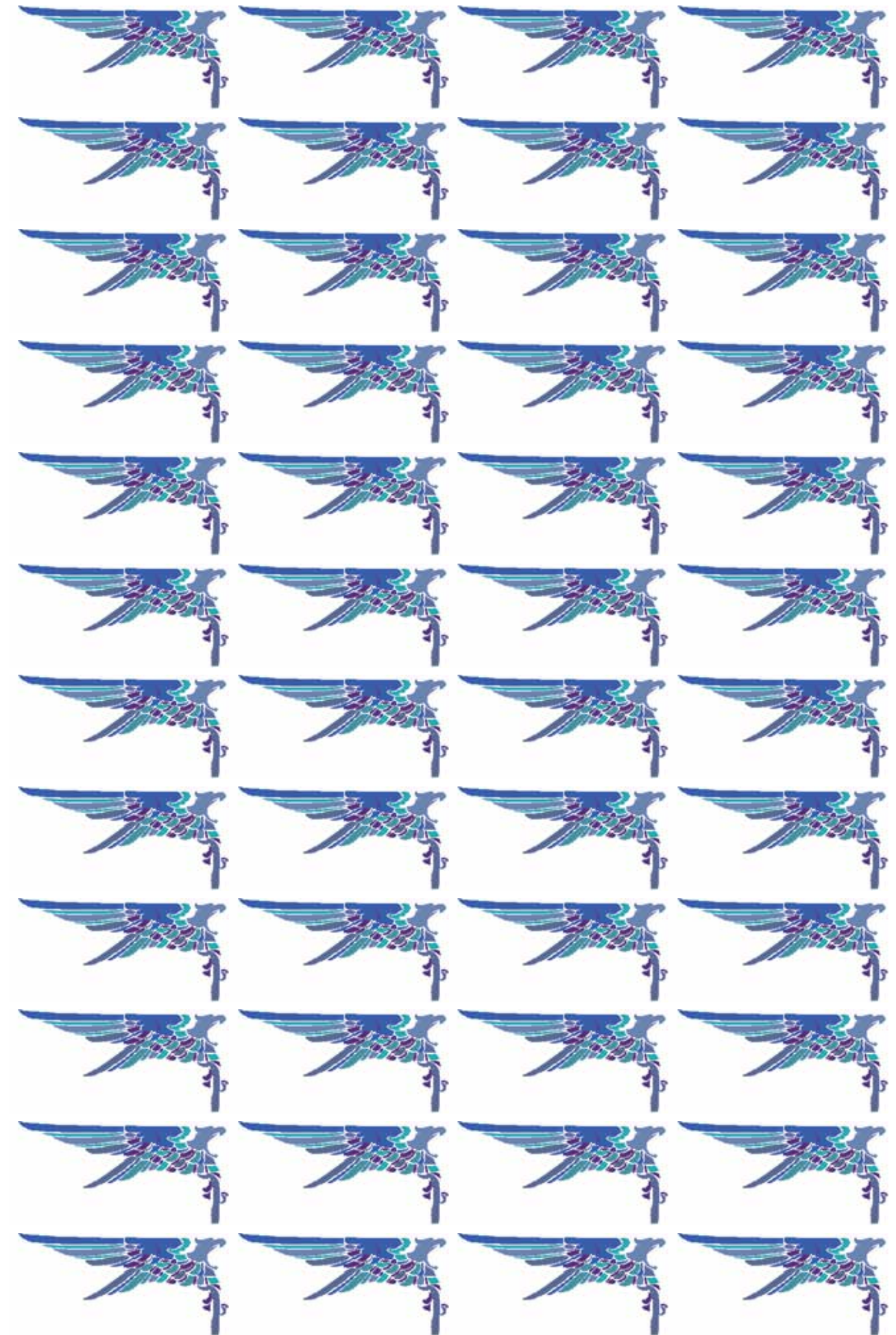
Dream Cachë

Definition of Art:

What is Prophetic Art?

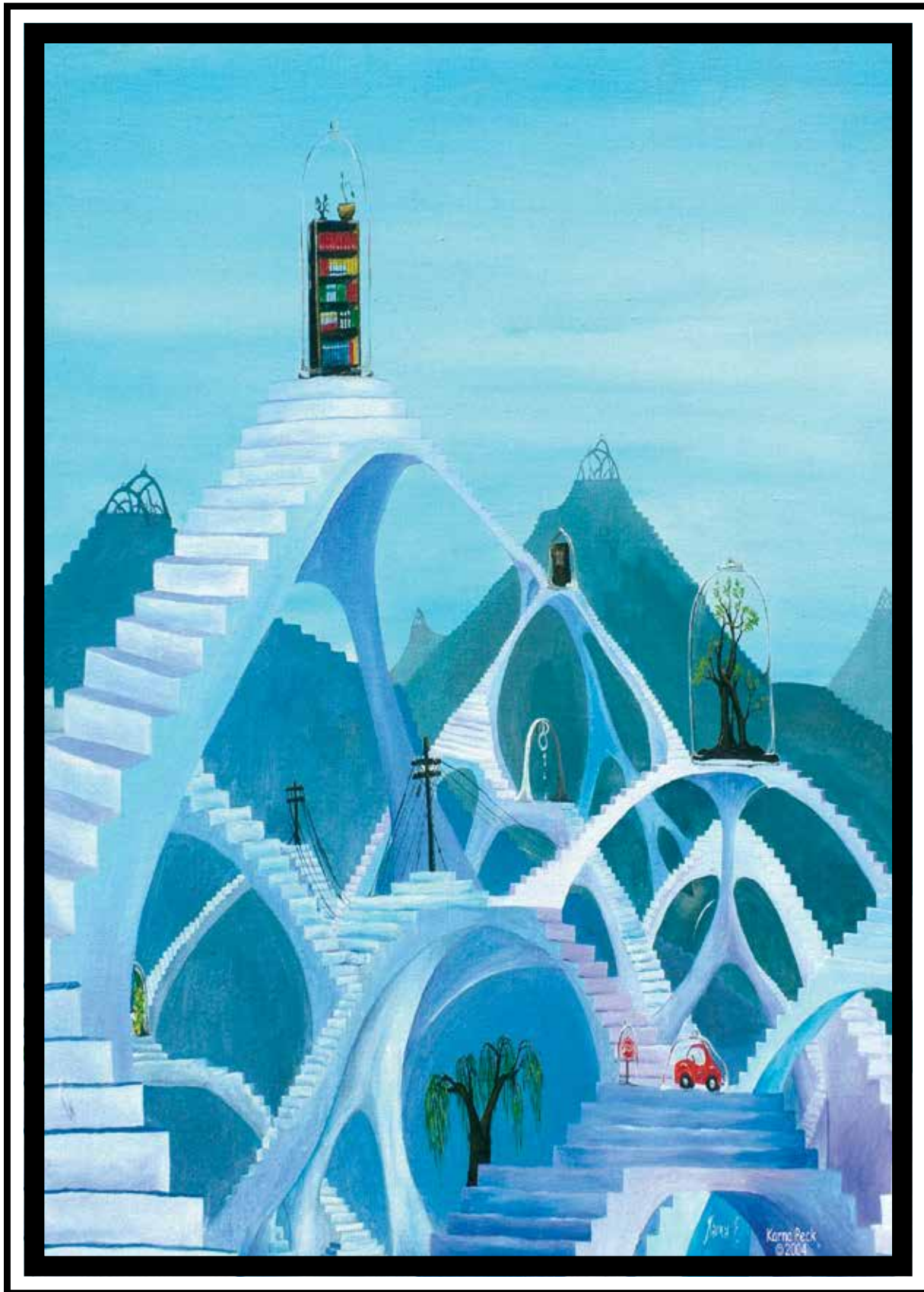
God is displayed in all creation.

When we pray, God answers us. When He does, often, we don't recognize it because it isn't in a form that we are looking for. We don't see the art as messages from God because we don't fathom His Love for us His constant desire to be in our life. He comes into our world in unusual ways. We were created by God in the beginning to keep Him company. (Gen 3:8). In the beginning Adam and Eve walked side by side with God. God desires communication with us. He has sought us from the time He created us. We turn away from him. We lost our relationship with Him when Adam and Eve sinned in the Garden of Eden (Gen 3:24). Every since then He has been working on a plan to get us back into His presence.

He speaks, but often we do not recognize him because we don't recognize his voice. (John 10:4) And if we don't recognize his voice, how will we know which way to go? Following the voice of God will provide direction to our lives.

This is how I see God trying to talk to us: He is big, after all he created the whole world including all the galaxies. Let's suppose he wants to get a message to us. Pretend you are big and have a family of ants that you want to get a message to. They would not understand the things in your 'big' world because they only see things from their perspective in the grass. They don't speak English and you do not speak 'ant language' so the only means of communication you could use is to select things from their environment as teaching tools and demonstrate what you want to teach them. In a similar manner, God doesn't speak 'English' because he is God and we are not. He is so far above us that we can not understand him either. But because he desires to get his messages across, he picks things that we can relate to in our little scope of the world and demonstrates teaching principles. He gives us visions and we must bring them into our consciousness and transfer them onto a medium that can be visualized with our eyes before we can understand what he wants to teach us.

He uses the things in creation and puts them onto the canvas of our minds. The gifts he has instilled in us transfer them to the canvas. He uses the canvas of our minds to draw his pictures. A picture has to be visualized by an artist before it can be painted. When an artist has this 'vision' burned on his mind, he cannot rest until it is let out by what ever medium he uses to display his ideas. God delivers his messages through assigning individuals to specific duties in the Kingdom of God.

Buttons and Rope

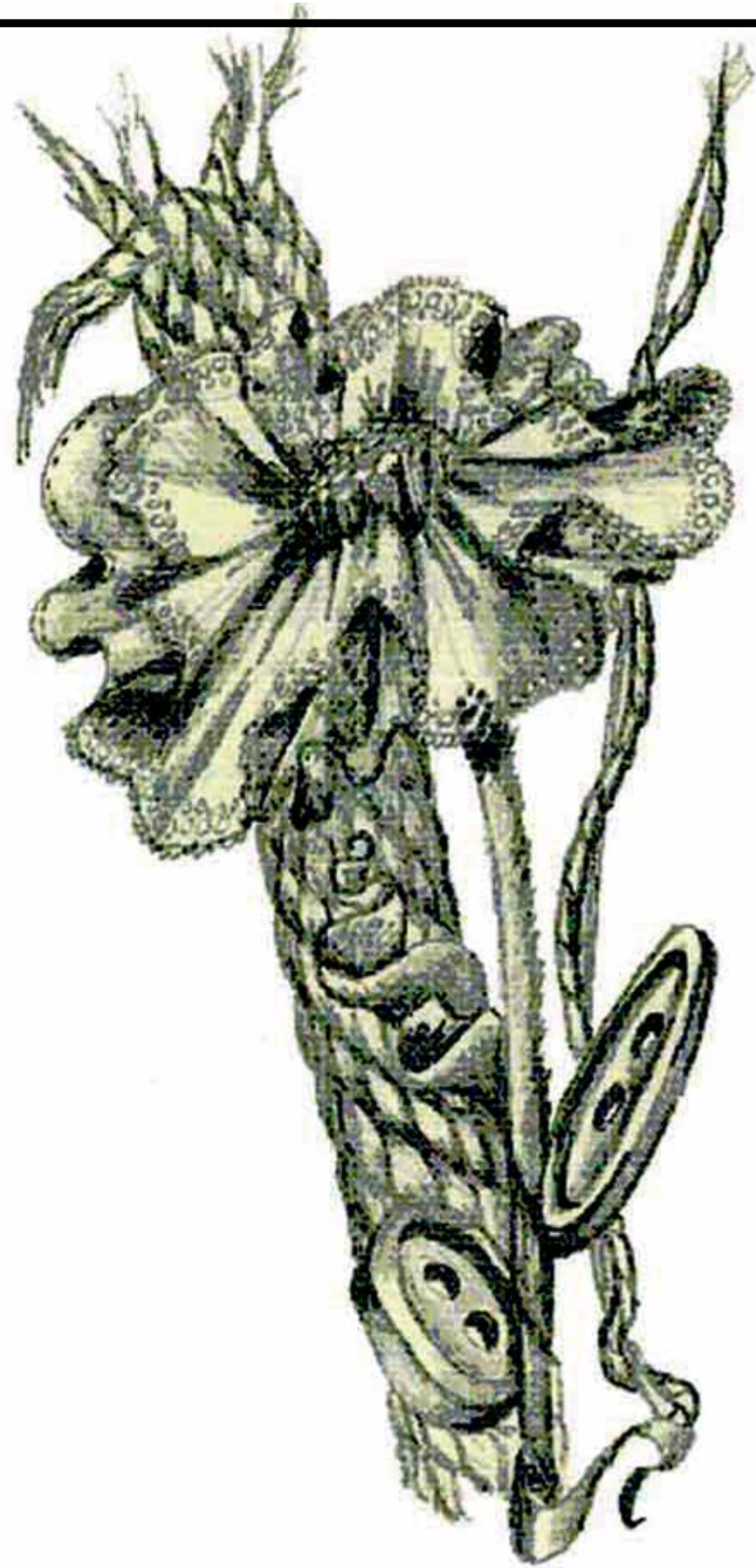
Indeed the things which our Lord gives to us

Why does he give us the Message?

Obedience to use the gifts God has entrusted us with allows us to become slaves to righteousness which leads to Holiness. Sharing our gifts with others brings unification of the body of Christ and permits others to enter into our acceptable sacrifice of Praise.

Many times others do not see our 'talent'. We may become discouraged. But, we must remember that we are living in a time that the enemy is fighting hard against us. He knows that he has only a short time and he will be chained in Hell forever. Even though, as loyal servants of Christ, we are spread out, do not be discouraged. He has called us and He will multiply us because of His righteousness. We are supposed to bring everything into the house of God, so the temple can be built. God needs every tool for the Kingdom of God to be built. Just because others may say that your art is bad, in God's eyes it is an essential tool that he needs to display his character and teaching. We are the display of God's righteousness to the world through our gifts in unity with our relationship in Christ Jesus. As children of God, he calls us stars in his Kingdom. He wants us to shine for Him. Just like comets, we are in motion and each display a tail of a different color. No two stars are alike. We all shine for him, but display different characteristics within his Kingdom. There may be many with similar gifts, but each has a wonderful tail of a different color.

Visions and Dreams

A vision is a "Mental representation of external objects, or scenes. An object that comes up in the mind." (Funk & Wagnall's Dictionary).

In order for an artist to paint a picture, he must first have a mental representation of it. It has to be built in his mind. He has to visualize it, dream it. Then, in obedience to the vision, he puts it into action and builds it, "just like he saw it". In essence, artists have visions that are transferred to canvas. The impressions are first 'etched' on their mind, then transferred to the paper for others to see. They try to make it 'just like they saw it.'

There are over one hundred references to dreams and visions in the Bible. Many individuals had visions. In Acts 10, Cornelius has a vision in which God tells him to accept Paul and pray over him to receive his sight again. Each of the book of Prophecy in the Scriptures are visions that have been transferred

to paper by the author when God ‘etched’ it on their mind. Jeremiah, Ezekiel, and Revelation all are written in symbolic form. They could be ‘painted’. They are all visionary and prophetic. Often God speaks to us in an unconventional manner. We need to be open to listen to Him.. We do not limit God when we don’t listen to Him, we limit His work in our lives

Scripture:

He who has a dream let him tell it, He who has my word speak it faithfully. What does straw have to do with wheat? Is not my word a fire and a hammer that breaks the rock into pieces? (Jer 23:28-30).

We are not to ignore the visions, but to become faithful to speak their meaning faithfully according to God’s intention of the message. The visions are to have a firm foundation in the Scriptures. I do not believe a vision that I cannot find a foundation for. As we trust God for the foundation of each vision, He is faithful. Visions come to life can add tremendous faith to your walk with God.

Artists are Prophets

All artists are prophets, but there are different gifting within the levels of prophecy in the Kingdom of God. Every Christian who has the Holy Spirit dwelling within him, has the ‘word of God’ etched on their heart. If that individual is an artist, then the Holy Spirit will flow out with greater intensity through their gift of art. Because God encompasses all and all, his voice can even be heard through artists that are not filled with the Holy Spirit and have entered the Kingdom of God through salvation through Jesus Christ.

There are those with a special gift of prophecy who have a close relationship with God. He has taught them to listen well, and tell the desires of his heart to others. They know his character because they have spent time getting to know him. They know that God signs His art work. The deeper level of prophecy is associated with intimacy with Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit. Paul, in the New Testament, said it was a desire of his heart that all would become prophets to this level. God desires us all to recognize His signature. He is doing a lot of art work that we are not crediting Him for.

Historically, God has spoken to his people through Prophets. A prophet was an individual who became the ‘mouthpiece’ of God. The Lord would put words into their mouth and send them to speak to groups of people to get them to follow His ways. These individuals were consecrated (set apart) and anointed (given special ability) to do whatever mission God wanted them to do. Moses, Aaron, Jeremiah, Isaiah, John the Baptist were prophets.



Thinking in Color

Visions and dreams throughout the Bible provide direction: Daniel 2:3 Nebuchadnezzar had a dream. His spirit became “anxious to understand the dream.” He knew that he must interpret the dream because it was telling him how to run the kingdom. The dream ended up being interpreted by Daniel. It provided information needed to warn about a famine that was to come onto the land.

Art is the Word of God Visualized: It is special

The Holy Scriptures are different from other words. This is the Word of God. It pierces between our soul and spirit. It is able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart (Heb 4:12). Our soul is the self drive of appetites and desires. We know what we want and attempt to get it. The Spirit of man is the activating force within living being. Notice in Genesis that God Breaths into Adam the breath of life. This is the spiritual aspect of Adam being born. (Gen 2:7).

Art moves both our soul and our spirit. When the art is not understood in relation to God, the creator, then our soul is stirred yet our Spirit remains hungry for God. It is the Breath of the Almighty gives us understanding (Job 32:8).

The Holy Spirit was given to us when Jesus ascended to heaven. He provides us with the ability to know God. He is correlated with ‘wind’ or breath. We know that no man has the ability to breath apart from God giving him that breath. God retains power over our death and life. This is the essence of the Spirit. It’s about the breath: wind provides movement to the walk (Jn 3:8). The spirit of us is the life center retained by God. No man has authority to restrain the wind with the wind, or authority over the day of death: (Ecc 8:8). When God take away our spirit, we expire (Ps 104:29).

When we become the Breath of God

Many times we think that it is our soul, our will that dominates our moral character. But this is not true. When we are born again, the Holy Spirit takes up residence in our spirit. This Holy Spirit writes his laws on our hearts. He etches his character on us. His character of Holiness. (Prov 16:18, Hos 4:12). His Spirit within us will provide the source of one’s insight. It is the Holy

Spirit within us that etches the impressions on the mind and then helps us to interpret them to bring them to the paper. (ICor 2:11)

When we become children of God through belief in Jesus Christ as our Savior, we become sensitive to inner voice of Holy Spirit. We receive a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out “Abba! Father!.(Rom 8:15). This new adoption enables us to think spiritually dominated by God. The Spirit Himself (God’s Holy Spirit) testifies with our spirit that we are children of God (Rom 8:16). The same new spirit gives mind of Christ to believer (I Cor 2:16). You are renewed in the spirit of your mind when you have the new spirit. When we focus on God, then he will to talk into your mind. He will etch the ‘word of God’ on your painting. Hebrews 10:16 says, “ This is the covenant that I will make with them: After those days, says the Lord: I will put My laws upon their heart, and on their mind I will write them.”

When we become Christians, then we are to serve in the midst of the others. We come as an empty vessel, a cup, and he fills us up with whatever he sees will bring us the ultimate happiness. We hold in our hands whatever we are supposed to give to others on behalf of him. We display his love to the world through the use of our gifts when we offer praise to him for them. We are not responsible for the results, only to give the cup. To give of ourselves. We must leave the results of our ministry in the hands of the master artist, God

How to interpret Art

God is everywhere, because he created everything, so anything that can be put on canvas displays something to be learned about his Kingdom. Therefore, artists who are not Christians still display the Character of God. Just as those who are not saved, have dreams related to God, so they can do art. Art is bringing to life a vision or dream. The bible is the primary way that God desires to speak to us. All who are born again to new life through a relationship with Jesus Christ to God as taking care of our sin will be able to hear from God.

The Bible says that , “ As for you, the anointing which you received from Him abides in you, and you have no need for anyone to teach you; but as His anointing teaches you about all things, and is true and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you also will abide in the Son and in the Father (I John 2:24).

To interpret it according to God, you have to follow his rules. Follow the steps in respect to the directory that he has laid out for us already. The Holy Bible.

1. **Ask God to help you understand** what he wants to teach you. He desires to teach us about his character, so he will always come through with this prayer.
2. **Look at the picture.** Take one item at a time. You may write down the words that depict the pictures. Often they have several meanings. Look them

up in a dictionary. The message will be simple. It will also be multicultural. Generally, the message will be repeated several times throughout the painting.
3. Look in the Bible for the items. A concordance will help to find things. The message of the should move us closer to God because that is the goal of God in all of His interactions with us.

For example: If there is a picture of a plow, search the scriptures and find verses with the word 'plow' in them. Then list the character of the plow. This leads you to what Gods wants to tell you. The message has something to do with being a 'sower of the word ' : one that prepares individuals to receive the seed of the Word (Jesus).

Another example: A picture of small trees growing in little pots on the stairs of the altar in a Church Sanctuary. If you research, you will see that God desires to make us to be a Church that plants seedlings. We are to be planted in good soil. (Isa 61:11). You might continue research and build on this foundation. More information is found about trees by following cross references in a regular Bible. Isa 61 has trees. Jesus also, talks about the seed being planted in Matt 13.
