Protection and Safety from Danger/Harm or Evil Influences:

- John 17:11 – That God will keep them through His name
- Isa. 54:17 – that no weapon against them will succeed
- 2 Thess. 3:3 – that God will guard them and establish them

Discernment and Acceptance of Truth in all areas:

- John 8:32 – that they will know the truth and be free
- John 17:17 – that God would set us apart by His truth
- John 16:13 – God's Spirit would lead them into all truth in all areas of life, including a relationship with Jesus
- 1 John 4:1-6 – they test what they are exposed to and discern truth from error

Peace and a Sound Mind:

- 2 Tim. 1:7 – that God would grant them love, power and a sound mind with no confusion, unrest or fear
- Phil. 4:8-9 – to think on the good things God says to think about
- Isa. 54:13 – the great peace promised here

Establishing in Righteousness:

- Isa. 54:14 – to establish them in righteousness and keep fear far from them
- 2 Thess. 3:3 – to establish them and keep them from evil
- 1 Thess. 3:13 – to establish them in holiness

Relationship with Jesus Christ:

- John 3:16 – know Jesus' love and believe on Him for salvation
- Rom. 10:9-10 – call on Jesus and believe in His atoning work to forgive sins and save
- 2 Thess. 3:5 – direct them into the love of God

Good works:

- Eph. 2:10 – they walk in the good works God fashioned for them to do
- Gal. 6:9-10 – not be weary in doing good works
- Tit. 3:8 – they maintain a lifestyle of good works
- Col. 1:10 – be effective in their good works

Their calling and destiny:

- Psa. 139:16 – they walk in the destiny God fashioned for them
- Eph. 2:10 – they do the works God created for them
- Psa. 37:23 – they walk in the steps God orders for them

Excellence and prospering in school and life:

- 3 John 1:2 – they succeed in reaching their potential
- John 16:13 – Holy Spirit show them the way into all truth
- Josh. 1:8-9 – They keep, obey, and remember God’s Word daily

Soundness and wholeness in body, soul and mind:

- Isa. 54:13 – they experience God’s great *shalom* in all of life
- 1 Tim. 1:7 – experience soundness of mind
- Psa. 119:165 – they love God’s Word and find great peace
- Psa. 139:13-18 – they appreciate and be at peace with who God made them to be and how precious they are to Him
- Psa. 8:3-4 – that they would know that the God who created the universe thinks about and cares for them
- 1 Pet. 5:7 – they would know that God cares about what matters to them
- Rom. 5:8 – know God’s great love for them

Growing in knowledge and understanding:

- 2 Pet. 3:18 – they grow in the grace and in the knowledge of Jesus
- 1 Pet. 2:2 – they desire God’s Word to grow as His disciple
- Col. 1:10 – they be increasing in the knowledge of God

Revelation of God and Eternal Life:

- John 17:3 – they come to know God through faith in His Son, Jesus Christ
- 2 Tim. 1:9-10 – they understand the truth of the Gospel of Jesus Christ
- Rom. 5:8 – understand God’s great love

Christian virtues and foundation:

- 2 Pet. 1:5-8 – that they will have solid foundation and add these virtues
- 1 Cor. 3:10-11 – that they build upon the foundation of Christ with care and precision
- Eph. 1:4 – they be holy and without blame built on the foundation of Jesus Christ
- Jude 1:20 – they be built up in the faith

Led by and sensitive to Holy Spirit:

- John 16:13 – they be led by the Holy Spirit
- Luke 4:1 – they be led by the Holy Spirit as Jesus was
- 1 Pet. 1:22 – they obey the truth through the power of the Holy Spirit and have true love for others

Conviction and Repentance when needed:

- 2 Tim. 3:15-16 – that Word of God works these things in them as needed, including correction
- Rom. 2:4 – that the goodness of God will lead them to repentance when needed
- Acts 3:26 – that the blessing of God would come to them to turn them from sin when needed
- Acts 17:30 – that they will repent of sins when needed
- 2 Pet. 3:9 – that they repent as needed
- 1 John 1:9 – that they confess sins when needed
