

NORTHWEST FLORIDA SPECIES GUIDE

Get to know your local shells

This guide is designed to provide you with a one-stop source to obtain information on the scientific and visual aspects of the shells found in the Florida Panhandle. The list is not exhaustive as new species are being found quite often. The data contained herein is current as of February, 2026

The list follows the model of the NW Florida Species List, Edition 13, Brant Holman, editor. The 13th Edition can be found on the club's website (<https://gulfcoastshellclub.com>). The first section covers the Gastropods and goes alphabetically by family and within the family by genus and species. The second section includes Scaphopoda (Tusk Shells), Polyplacophora (Chiton Shells), Bivalves (Clams, etc.) and Cephlopoda (Octopus and Spirula). Please report any errors you may find.

HOW TO USE THIS CHECKLIST

Each species entered on the list consists of two lines:

In the top line you have the genus and species name, the common name, and the size range in millimeters (25.4mm = 1 inch). Clicking on this line will take you to the World Register of Marine Species (WoRMS) and to the specific page for, in this case, *Acteon candens*. At this site you can find such information as the full taxonomic tree to which *Acteon candens* belongs, note whether any name changes have occurred, verify the Author and date of naming are correct, and (scrolling down to the gray bar) you can find the shells distribution and, occasionally, pictures. This is a great help if you are cataloging your shells or preparing labels for a shell show.

The second line (indented) will take you to a site that has one or more pictures of the shell. In the vast majority of the cases these will be from gastropods.com (a site created by Eddie Hardy and now managed by the Poppe's at Conchology.be). This site was selected because it usually displays several shells showing the variety within the species. The site often provides Common Names and where they are found. On occasion the locations will not include the Panhandle but the shells do exist here.
