QUALIFICATIONS

Management – I have been the Project Manager, Superintendent, or Working Superintendent on numerous projects. I am well-spoken, articulate, and knowledgeable within construction and government-related-construction. I am well acquainted with the atmosphere, reporting requirements, timelines, documentation, specifications, safety requirements and various challenges; confident in my abilities to lead, manage, schedule, and direct a team to achieve the common goal. I understand the expectations of the client; possessing a solid amount of knowledge & experience from many years as a tradesman. I am goal-oriented, thriving in stressful situations.

Carpentry – Rough and finish carpentry. I am an experienced, confident, and professional carpenter, very capable of all aspects of my trade. Within the US government work atmosphere, I have professionally installed windows and doors (interior and exterior: standard, FE/BR, and STC-rated), acoustical ceilings, drywall hanging, taping & finishing, painting, carpet, acoustical wall panels, trim carpentry, and many other tasks too numerous to mention. I consider myself a bit of a perfectionist and take great pride in the finished product.

FE/BR Technician – I have successfully installed FDI, Norshield, Ross, & Habersham products. From unpacking & installation to finishes of windows, glazings, doors, vault doors, and louvres. I am knowledgeable, capable, and able to professionally install all FE/BR products.

Furniture Installer – I have been the primary furniture installer on many jobs. Occasionally involved in redesigning furniture layouts to accommodate the unforeseen. I am more than capable and confident in the professional and timely installation of both Knoll and Eaton-branded furnitures.

General Construction – Although my primary trade is a carpenter, on many occasions, I have been on small job crews and have assisted other trades. I am very willing and able to bend conduit, basic wiring, basic plumbing, HVAC, wall-finishing, plaster, stucco, pipe-insulating, duct-insulating, etc. I also maintain my Class-A Commercial Driver's License also, and am a very capable forklift operator.

Isolated Power Installations / Troubleshooting – Frequently on job crews I have installed or assisted installing isolated power. I have been involved in all aspects, from the panel to individual circuits. In addition, I have successfully diagnosed and remedied existing systems in locating and repairing faults.

I have worked as an intelligence analyst, a security escort, carpenter, FE/BR tech., superintendent, project manager, and Bavak gate installer. I am very familiar with the security procedures involved within these facilities, as well as the responsibilities, requirements, and management of an individual and construction crew within the USG atmosphere.
