



Spring Pistol Postal

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The purpose of this postal match is to offer all pistol competitors, both new and experienced, an opportunity to participate in a nationwide pistol postal competition. Competitors may enter in one or more of the caliber breakdowns. Awards will be made in each caliber group, as well for aggregate scores for shooters in multiple caliber groups and other special shooting groups such as Senior (55+ years old), Women, New Shooters and Collegiate.

MATCH CONDITIONS

This course of fire may be shot indoors or outdoors. Competitors acknowledge that if they choose to shoot outdoors, they may be at a disadvantage due to wind/light and other outside conditions. ELIGIBILITY: Only one entry per caliber group per individual. Membership in a national pistol organization is not required to enter.

FIRING AND CLOSING DATES: Firing may be done any time between April 1st and October 30th. Entries may be sent in at any time provided scores are received no later than 30 days after the last day of firing (this makes the entry deadline November 30th).

TARGETS: Targets will not be provided. Three NRA Official 50 Foot Slow Fire Pistol Targets (B-2), or equivalent, are required. Competitors will shoot a total of three targets for each caliber group that they choose to enter (Small Bore/Rim Fire, Intermediate Caliber Pistol, Large Caliber Pistol). Competitors must identify their targets prior to firing by signing the back of each target and labeling it with the date of fire and distance. Targets are not required to be returned, but should be retained in the event of a challenge. Those who are in the Central Florida area may pickup free targets for their postal shoot at Twilight Firearms at 813 North Blvd West, Leesburg, FL 34748.

EQUIPMENT: Competitors may fire in one or more of the following caliber groups. Each will be scored independently, but shooters aggregate scores will also earn them additional awards. All firearms used in this competition must have iron sights.

COURSE OF FIRE: The course of fire consists of a total of thirty rounds fired in a total of six five round strings, two strings being fired at one of three targets at prescribed distances. One target will be fired at 12 feet (4 yards), 21 feet (7 yards) and 50 feet (16-2/3 yards). Two five-round strings will be fired into each target at each distance. Competitors may choose to use six targets instead, firing one five round string at each target. Shooting will be slow fire, allowing 5 minutes per string. Each distance must be fired in a single session, but different distances may be fired on different days to accommodate the needs of the shooters.

SCORING: All targets will be scored locally by the competitors. It is not required to mail targets in with the entry. Please send only the completed score sheets. You may email scores to paul@twilightfirearms.com or fax to (352) 801-7589. All record firing must be witnessed by a fellow shooter.

ENTRY FEE: \$10.00 per entry in each caliber group. Payment may be made by check or credit card. Make checks payable to Twilight Firearms.

AWARDS: A minimum of three shooters must compete in a category in order to make the award. An engraved plaque with the match name, shooter's name and score will be issued to the top scorer in each of the following categories.

- AGGREGATE AWARD WINNER
- SMALL BORE/RIM FIRE
- INTERMEDIATE PISTOL
- LARGE CALIBER PISTOL

ADDITIONAL AWARDS: Additional awards will be made to the high scorer in each of the above groups who qualify for the specialty groups provided that there are at least three qualifying competitors: Seniors (55+ years old), Women, Collegiate (shooters who are currently 21-years old or younger) and New Shooters (shooters who have never shot in any competition or postal match).
