

I have served as the Republican Precinct Chair in Precinct 410 since 2018.

Before that, I:

...was honored to serve for 8 years in the **U.S. Air Force** during the Viet Nam “conflict” and through the transition to a volunteer military force.

...earned degrees in Business Administration and Electrical Engineering.

...accomplished a rewarding **34-year engineering career** for a local aircraft manufacturer.

...moved to Willow Park in 1987 with my wife, Peggie, and raised two children.

...was invited to serve on the Willow Park Planning & Zoning Commission in 1991.

...was elected to the **Willow Park City Council** seven times over three periods:

1992-1994, 1997-2001, and 2009-2017.

And was selected by the Council as Mayor Pro Tem for 8 of those 14 years.

...have served as an **Election Judge** in Parker County since 2014.

...have been a voting delegate to every Republican State Convention since 2012.

As your Precinct Chair, I:

...Chaired the Parker County Republican Party Resolution Committee for six years.

...helped write the current Bylaws for the Parker County Republican Party.

...trained other Precinct Chairs on conducting Precinct Conventions.

...was **elected by my peer Precinct Chairs to Chair the Senate District 30**

Conventions in 2022, 2024, and again in 2026. I also developed the process we now use to plan for those events.

But what have I done Lately:

· In 2022, personally educated Republican Party of Texas Platform Committee on an ignored problem and successfully created a Platform revision currently documented as plank [76. (e)] that states: “Close the loophole called the ‘Unused Increment Rate,’ which allows taxing entities to bypass recently added limits to increases in property taxes.”

· This resulted in proposed legislation in 2023 that was killed in committee.

· Similar proposed legislation in 2025 again died in committee.

· This fight to control property tax increases is not over.

· In 2025, through just the 3 minutes allowed under “citizen comments” in every meeting for a year, successfully persuaded the Parker County Hospital District to keep their property tax rate at the No-New-Revenue rate for the first time ever.

· In 2025, I was selected to Chair a Commission to draft a Home Rule Charter for the City of Willow Park. That Home Rule Charter is expected to be on the local election ballot in May, 2026.
