RANGE SAFETY RULES

- 1. No one is allowed on the range under the influence of alcohol or any other controlled substance.
- 2. No loaded firearms are to enter or exit the facility. All magazines and speed loaders must be unloaded. Loaded firearms at firing line only. No firearms are permitted in the store area without being in a locked container, range bag or case.
- Firearms may be inspected at the check-in counter at the request of staff. Any firearms or ammunition found to be unsafe or unserviceable will not be allowed on the range.
- 4. All handguns and rifles subject to approval. Shotguns are not allowed.
- 5. Two shooters allowed per lane. No spectators allowed in shooting bay. All persons entering the range will be charged accordingly.
- 6. Eye and ear protection MUST be worn at ALL TIMES on the range.
- 7. Unauthorized targets are not permitted on the range. Shooting at anything other than your own target is strictly prohibited.
- 8. No target "head" shots for inexperienced shooters. Shots must be a minimum of 15" below the target hangers.
- 9. Wearing or drawing from a holster is NOT permitted.
- 10. The muzzle of all firearms must be kept pointed downrange at all times. If leaving the range temporarily, leave all firearms on the firing line unloaded with the action open and the muzzle pointing downrange. The following gun handling rules must be obeyed at all times:
 - a. Always keep your gun pointed downrange
 - b. Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to fire
 - c. Always keep action open and firearm unloaded until ready to shoot
 - d. Identify your target and what is behind the target
 - e. Be sure the gun is safe to operate
 - f. Know how to use the gun safely
 - g. Use only the correct ammunition for your specific gun
 - h. Unload, open action, remove magazine and bench all firearms during cease-fire.
- 11. All firearms must arrive and leave in a range case. No uncased firearms may leave the shooting booth area.
- 12. If a misfire or other malfunction occurs, keep the firearm pointed downrange an signal the range staff. Place the firearm on the bench with the muzzle pointed downrange and obtain assistance. DO NOT leave the firing line with a loaded or jammed gun.
- 13. All firearms and ammunition are subject to inspection by the staff.
- 14. This business shall not be held liable for any damages incurred from use of ammunition. Customer will resolve any issues with the product manufacturer.
- 15. No fast or rapid firing allowed. Allow at least 3 seconds between shots. Any hazardous behavior WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL FROM THE PREMISIS.
- 16. Comply with all instructions from the range staff.
- 17. Report any unsafe conduct to the range staff immediately.
- 18. Do not remove any brass from the range.
- 19. Any violation of range safety rules will result in IMMEDIATE REPRIMAND and possible DISMISSAL from the range.
- 20. THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS OF ANY KIND FOR PARTIES EXPELLED FROM THE RANGE FOR SAFETY VIOLATIONS.
